

- (F) To convene and promote conferences, study and action groups, public meetings, workshops, seminars and similar functions to identify the problems of poverty and distress in Eritrea and their solution and to bring together engineers, technicians, social and natural scientists, economists, agronomists, medical specialists, environmental health and other specialists, teams of volunteers and professional persons either in the United Kingdom or in Eritrea or elsewhere concerned with such problems and to disseminate the useful results of such functions.
- (G) To accept subscriptions donations, devises, and grants and to issue appeals, hold public meetings and take such other steps as may be required for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the Association in the shape of donations, subscriptions or otherwise provided that the Association shall not undertake any permanent trading activities in raising funds for its charitable object.
- (H) To purchase or hire any equipment, plant, furniture, or chattels reasonably required for the object of the Association.
- (I) To purchase, take on lease, or in exchange hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal estate which may be deemed necessary for the purposes of the Association and to construct, maintain, and alter buildings or erections.
- (J) Subject to such consents as are required by law to sell, manage, lease, mortgage, dispose of or otherwise deal with any or any part of the property of the Association.
- (K) Subject to such consents as are required by law to borrow, or raise money for the object of the Association on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit.
- (L) To invest the moneys of the Association not immediately required for its purposes in or upon such shares, stocks, funds, securities or other investments in any part of the world as the Association shall in its absolute discretion think fit.
- (M) To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills, cheques, and other instruments and to operate bank accounts.
- (N) To make any reasonable and necessary provision for the payment of pensions and superannuation to or on behalf of employees or former employees and their spouses and other dependants.
- (O) To engage and pay any person or persons whether on a full time or part time basis and whether as consultant or employee to supervise, organise, carry on the work of and advise the Association.
- (P) To amalgamate with any companies, institutions, societies or associations which shall be charitable in law and have objects altogether or mainly similar to those of the Association and prohibit the payment of any dividend or profit to and the distribution of any of their assets amongst their members at least to the same extent as such payments or distributions are prohibited in the case of members of the Association by this Memorandum of Association.
- (Q) To make any donations in cash or assets or establish or support aid in the establishment or support of or contribute or lend money with or without security to or for any charitable institution, corporation, fund, trust or purposes having or including purposes similar to the object of the Association.
- (R) To undertake and execute any charitable trust.
