HOOK

Welcome back to Next Gen! As we wrap up our series on families, I want to share Julio's story with you. Julio, a 6th grader, grew up without a dad and lacked a positive male role model. Julio started hanging out with an older group of guys who introduced him to vaping and sneaking out late at night. Talk about great friends, right? Despite their "friendship," Julio still felt lonely and disconnected.

Julio started attending Next Gen Club at his school, where he met Josh, a mentor who actually cared about him. Josh's kindness was new to Julio, but he really trusted him, so when Josh invited him to his youth group, he tried it out. There, Julio met friends who didn't drink or get into trouble but encouraged him to focus on school and God. This group became like family to him, and the church gave him the sense of belonging he had been missing. His friends at church didn't replace his family; they added to it! That's why we want you to know **You Can Find Family In Church.**

This month, we've been talking about families and how those relationships can be tough. You might be close to your family, and they're your best friends, or you may resent them because they've caused the most hurt and pain. Maybe you don't even like the idea of family because you've never seen a healthy one.
