

Next Gen Small Groups October Wk. 4 Your Vision Determines Your Direction

Key Verse: "Proverbs 29:18 – "Where there is no vision, the people get out of control, but whoever obeys instruction is happy."

SUMMARY

Life without vision is like walking blindfolded—you might move, but you'll drift and struggle to stay on course. Vision gives your life direction and purpose. It's not only about careers or material goals; vision can be about the kind of person you want to become, the impact you want to make, and the values you want to live by. God wants us to have vision because it helps us make wise choices, stay disciplined, and live a life of meaning. When you know where you're going, you can confidently make decisions that align with that goal. *Your Vision Determines Your Direction*.

ICEBREAKER

Raise your hand if you've ever gotten lost somewhere, even for a few minutes. How did it feel? What helped you find your way?

DISCUSSION STARTER

Why is having a vision for your life important, even if you don't know every step yet?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How does a lack of vision make life feel chaotic or out of control?
- 2. What are some areas of your life where you could use a clearer vision?
- 3. How can vision help you make better decisions today?
- 4. Who in your life could help you dream, plan, and stay accountable to your vision?
- 5. How can God guide you in forming your vision?

ACTIVITY:

Give each student a piece of paper. At the top, have them write: "My Vision for the Future."

Ask them to divide the paper into three sections: **Dream**, **Plan**, **Share**.

- **Dream:** Write one long-term goal or dream (5–20 years from now).
- **Plan:** Write one or two steps they can take in the next year to start moving toward that dream.
- **Share:** Write down one person they can share this vision with for encouragement and accountability.

After writing, invite students to share their vision with a partner in the group

WRAP-UP

Vision gives life purpose and direction. Without it, we drift, make impulsive decisions, and miss opportunities.
