SAE 40 MULTIGRADE OIL is a robust, high-performance multigrade oil (HPDO) designed for South African market requirements. It is formulated to sustain engine durability where exhaust reticulation is used and is intended for use with diesel fuels of up to 0.5% wt Sulphur. It controls and reduces soot induced wear, high temperature piston deposits, corrosion, foaming and oxidation. It provides good resistance to bore polishing, a high level of wear protection and ensures superior engine cleanliness at extended drain levels.

Applications

Recommended for use in heavy duty four stroke turbo charged and naturally aspirated diesel engines both on and off highway, burning high or low Sulphur diesel. It is highly effective in engines designed to meet the American exhaust emission standards, including those utilising hydraulically actuated fuel injection systems. It can be used in all diesel engines requiring the AOI specifications CH-4, CG-4, CF-4
