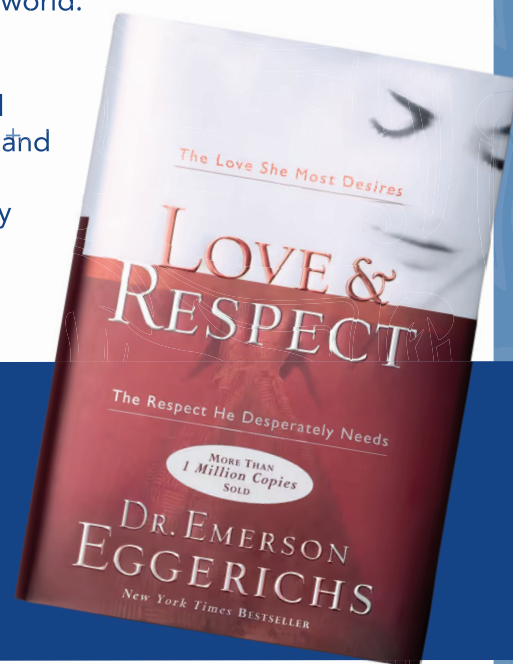
SPEAKER: **DR. EMERSON EGGERICHS**
