THE CHALLENGE

Invoices arrived faster than they could be typed

Abode's payables landed in batches of 50 or more, and every one had to be opened, read, and re-typed into Procore by hand. Many weren't clean: job numbers scribbled on by field staff, single invoices needing to be split across several projects before the costs landed in the right place. In Louisa's words, "it was tedious, time-consuming work that ate up a huge chunk of my day, torture!"

THE SOLUTION

A few working sessions, then the entry stopped

Invoices now arrive in the inBuild payable inbox and are read automatically: vendor, amounts, and line items extracted without keying. Louisa reviews the result, splits a document across projects where it needs splitting, and syncs it straight to Procore. The inBuild team worked with her over a handful of sessions to get the messier cases handled the way Abode actually works.

THE RESULTS

80% less data entry, and no dread
