Community Service

- One of our most successful events during our tenure as officers was the Arm in Arm volunteer endeavor.
 - Members of the club signed up to volunteer at the Arm in Arm pantry in Princeton through various time slots across days.
 - Created food baskets and interacted with the Princeton community and Arm in Arm workers.
- Within the University community, we currently have 5 SHARE peers, 10 RCAs, and several OA/CA leaders.

Sustainability

- A member of the club created a food waste study to discourage members from wasting food at meals.
- Several members who have taken part in the EcoRep Program stewarding sustainability projects on campus

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

- Since the DEI committee was formed four years ago, we have built a strong infrastructure to continue DEI efforts within the club.
- The DEI committee has expanded to 20 undergraduate members, including 15 juniors and 5 seniors.
- The DEI committee worked together to draft a DEI statement to be added to the TI Code of Conduct.
- The DEI committee led an extensive outreach initiative to underrepresented communities and communities of color on the Princeton campus to encourage them to consider TI.

- For pre-bicker events, we hosted several initiatives throughout the fall and winter to promote a diverse and inclusive membership:
- Our annual "Ladies Night Trivia" in the fall allowed female-identifying sophomores and juniors interested in bickering to meet current female members, hear about their experiences, and play fun TI-themed trivia.
 - We introduced a rejuvenated Affinity Group Open House event to the pre-bicker agenda, inviting interested sophomores to the club across three days to meet members from the same groups and to promote a comfortable club environment before the bicker process.
- We held two rounds of coffee chats and sophomore meal exchanges, where interested bickerees could request meetings with members from specific affinity groups: POC, FLI, Indigenous, Women, LGBTQIA+, and General Membership.
- This gave members the opportunity to answer questions about their experiences as TI members and within their affinity groups.
- The officer corps collaborated with the DEI committee and SHARE peers to lead our Pre-Bicker training, with a focus on making the bicker process as inclusive and comfortable as possible for sophomores.
- Bicker chair took initiative to ensure that bicker discussions were open, equitable, and inclusive of all members and bickerees.

Campus Presence

- Home to three Olympians, including a gold medalist fencer.
- 2-time victors in the University's Intramural League.
- Numerous Varsity and Club Athletics, including:
 - Water Polo, Squash, Fencing, Rowing, Wrestling, Sailing, Rugby, Swim & Dive, Field Hockey, Track, Volleyball, etc.
 - TI Members in Women's Squash playing an integral role in securing the Ivy Championship Title for Women's Squash 2026
- A strong presence in the Performing Arts, including:
 - Dance groups (Body Hype, Disiac, Expressions, Princeton University Ballet), Acapella groups (Tigressions, Shere Khan, Tigertones, Wildcats, Footnotes), other music groups (Princeton University Orchestra), film groups (Princeton Pictures).
- Active participation in Army ROTC, Veteran, and transfer student programs.
- Involvement in other extracurricular activities, including:
 - Coffee Club, Orange Key tour guides, Murray Dodge bakers, Art Museum program execs, editors for the *Daily Princetonian* and the *Nassau Weekly*, etc.
