Today in upper school chapel, Mr. Bradley continued his series focusing on Romans 12:9-21 and what sets true Christian love apart from all others. Today the focus was about our love extending to those who persecute us. We also talked about living in an understanding way with those around us by rejoicing with them at times and also weeping with them at times.

Romans 12:12-15 - Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep.

Today in lower school chapel, Pastor Ron Dazell shared about God's excellent greatness.

*Psalm 150:2 - Praise Him for His mighty deeds; praise Him according to His **excellent greatness!***

A.W. Tozer said the most important thing about us is what comes to mind when we think about God. In chapel today, we discussed the excellent greatness of God: His prominence, eminence, and preeminence. God's excellent greatness is literally His infinite excellence. We use words like holiness and majesty to describe God. It is overwhelming to read of His marvelous deeds and His glorious promises. However, at best we currently see as in a mirror dimly. Let us rejoice in the Most High God. Let us joyfully bow down and serve the King of kings and Lord of lords. Let us fear the Lord and submit to His will. Let us praise Him according to His excellent greatness. Let everything that has breath praise the Lord! Praise the Lord! (Psalm 150:6)
