Submission Deadline: Friday, May 15, 2026

In addition to academic background questions, Stage One of a completed Ebell/Flint Scholarship application requires the following:

A. Answers to each of the following three essay questions:

1. Your immediate and long-term academic and career goals including paid and unpaid internships and academically required field study or practicum work;
2. Your volunteer community service or extra-curricular involvement over the past two years, including leadership roles with any of these activities
3. Select either Option A or B below:
 - A. Personal challenges, obstacles, or setbacks you have faced including how you addressed the challenges.
 - B. Beyond what has already been shared, tell us about an aspect of your lived experience that is important to you and describe how it has shaped you and the way you contribute to your school or community.

- B. Three letters of recommendation from a faculty member, employer/supervisor, mentor/community leader, and/or coaches/academic counselors. Letters from family members or peers will not be considered. Reference letters are to be requested and submitted from within the application module.
- C. Official Transcripts: order then upload the most recent official transcripts (pdf) from each post-secondary school attended and proof of spring registration status.

Applicants must complete Stage One in order to progress to Stage Two

Stage Two: Financial Resources and Transfer Documentation: **due Wednesday, June 10th**

The following documents must be uploaded:

1. FAFSA Submission Summary (pdf)
2. Student Financial Aid Award Letter and Cost of Attendance (COA)
3. Letter of Acceptance: if transferring to a new school for the fall

TIP: Order your official transcripts and request letters of recommendations early to meet the application deadline.

All required questions and documentation must be completed for the application to be submitted. Once Stage One is fulfilled, the Stage Two: Financial Resources form opens:

Stage One must be submitted by 11:59 pm PST on Friday, May 15th.

Stage Two is due on Wednesday, June 10th.

- You may save and update your scholarship application as many times as you would like. However, once you submit each stage of the application your entry is final and you will not be able to make any other changes.
- You will receive a confirmation notice when you submit your final application. This notice will timestamp your application and enable you to print or save a copy of your final application submission. Please save the confirmation for your records.
- You will receive notification when a letter of reference is received.
- All applicants will be notified if they qualify for an interview. Please allow up to 6 weeks from the deadline date to get a response.
