Māori Fisheries Amendment Act changes

Te Ohu Kai Moana Trustee Limited (TOKMTL)

Responsibility for appointing directors to the board of TOKMTL:

- Currently Te Kawai Taumata
- Under MFAA iwi on a 1-vote-per MIO, RIO and RMO basis.

Aotearoa Fisheries Limited (AFL)


Responsibility for appointing directors to the AFL board:

- Currently TOKMTL
- Under MFAA AHC vote based on shareholding in accordance with the directions of the relevant MIO.

Design principles


New Director Appointment process must be designed for both TOKMTL and AFL guided by the following principles and considerations:

- Achieving 2015 Māori Fisheries Review outcomes;
- Ongoing engagement with MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO;
- Stability of governance and operations during the transition phase;
- · Compliance with relevant legislation; and
- Transparency and fairness.






Existing appointment authority - TOKMTL




TOKMTL appointment authority under MFAA






Existing appointment authority - AFL

TOKM to vote on behalf of RIO as Trustee until MIO status achieved


AHC vote on shareholding basis in accordance with direction of their MIO

2. Joint Iwi-Board Sub-Committee comprising of board and MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO reps – **48**% 3. External iwi committee of MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO reps – **29**%

4. Independent Panel – **10**%

2. Candidate Assessment

- 1. Committee does not assess candidates against skills criteria **20**%*
- 2. Committee assesses and ranks all candidates against skills criteria **40**%
- 3. Committee assesses candidates against skills criteria, only presents shortlist of candidates who best meet the skills criteria **40**%

4. Committee assesses all applications and presents recommendation on one preferred candidate – **0**%

3. Candidate appointment/voting


- 1. Election at Large all candidates presented without assessment **20**%
- 2. Election at Large all candidates assessed and ranked **25**%

- 3. Election of Committee recommended shortlisted candidates **40**%
- 4. MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO vote on whether to accept Committee appointment recommendation **15**%

*84% of respondents said all candidates should be assessed

AFL appointments process – Survey responses





2. Joint Iwi-Board Sub-Committee comprising of board and MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO reps – **42**% 3. External iwi committee of MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO reps – **26**%

4. Independent Panel – **11%**

2. Candidate Assessment

- 1. Committee does not assess candidates against skills criteria **21**%*
- 2. Committee assesses and ranks all candidates against skills criteria **21**%
- 3. Committee assesses candidates against skills criteria, only presents shortlist of candidates who best meet the skills criteria **47**%
- 4. Committee assesses all applications and presents recommendation on one preferred candidate **11**%

3. Candidate appointment/voting

- 1. Election at Large all candidates presented without assessment **21%**
- 2. Election at Large all candidates assessed and ranked 21%

- 3. Election of Committee recommended shortlisted candidates **47**%
- 4. MIO/RIO/AHC and RMO vote on whether to accept Committee appointment recommendation **11**%

*83% of respondents said all candidates should be assessed





TOKMTL OPTION 2 - External nominations committee, all candidates ranked







Assessment process	Nominations committee assesses all candidates against skills criteria and identifies a shortlist of the best candidates based on assessment results.	Nominations committee assesses all candidates against skills criteria and ranks candidates in order based on assessment results.
Candidate selection	Only shortlisted candidates are put forward for AHC vote. (Full list of candidates available upon request).	All candidates are put forward, in ranked order, for AHC vote.

- TOKMTL is currently engaging with MIO/AHC and RMO on draft appointment process options for the boards of AFL and TOKMTL.
- The appointments process options, together with draft policies and procedures, will also be included in the suite of draft MFAA documents which will be shared with iwi in October.
- MIO/AHC and RMO feedback is sought on the processes prior to the Board of TOKMTL approving the final versions in February 2026.
