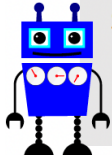




LO - I understand how to speak and write in Standard English

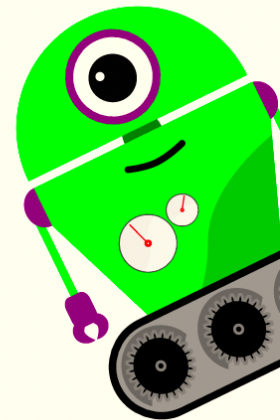
