

# THE STORY OF THE WATER CYCLE

Would you like to find out how the water cycle is, a continuous journey? Well, read on.

Did you know that the water cycle happens every day! From oceans and lakes, up into clouds, down onto land, into rivers and streams, back into the ocean. Would you like to find out just how this happens. Well read on to find out more.

## Evaporation

First the sun shines down on to the water. After being heated for long enough the water rises into a gas. This process is called evaporation.

## Condensation

Next the water vapor <sup>cools</sup> and <sup>turning</sup> condenses turning into white fluffy clouds this part of the process is called condensation.

## Precipitation

Then once <sup>cooled</sup> enough and the clouds can not hold any more the water vapor condenses again and turns into rain this process is called precipitation.
