



Joining to the Letter 'g'

Remember that 'g' is an unjoined letter so we never join from it, but we can join to it. Practise these joins to the letter 'g':

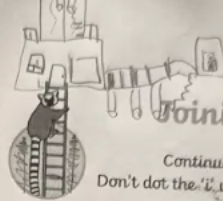
ag ag ag ag ag ag

Add the 'ag' letter pattern to the end of these words. Your 'a' can join on to your 'g' using a diagonal join.
