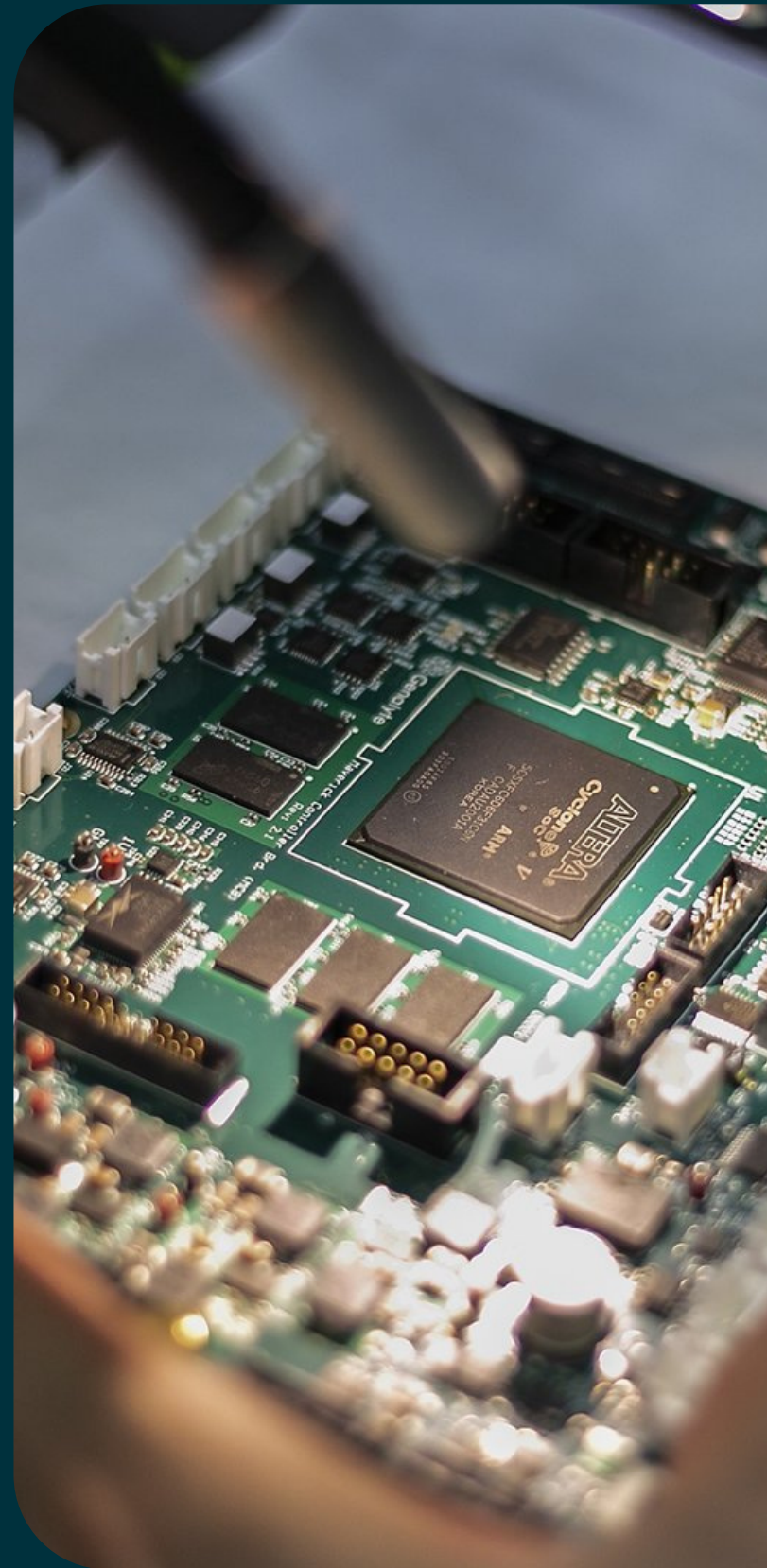
Early Indicators of Activity

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Strengthening Jalisco-UAE Economic Alliances in Space Technology, Health, and Sustainability at Expo Osaka 2025

LOCATION: OSAKA

Jalisco's Strategic Coordinator General, Mauro Garza Marín, met with UAE Commercial Office Director Mariam Almameri at Expo Osaka 2025 to strengthen economic and commercial alliances between Jalisco and the UAE. The meeting focused on key sectors such as space technology, health, and sustainability. The discussion highlighted a significant \$327 million trade volume between the two regions over the past seven years. Plans were made for the UAE to establish a presence in Jalisco through events like Expo Guadalajara, with support from local tourism and business authorities.
