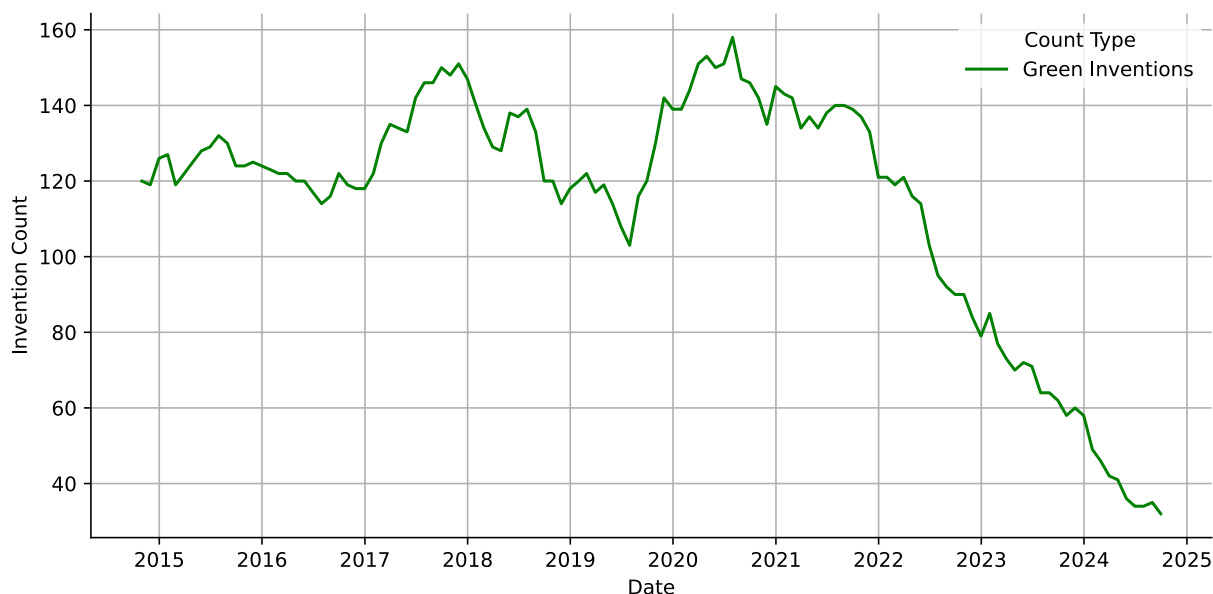

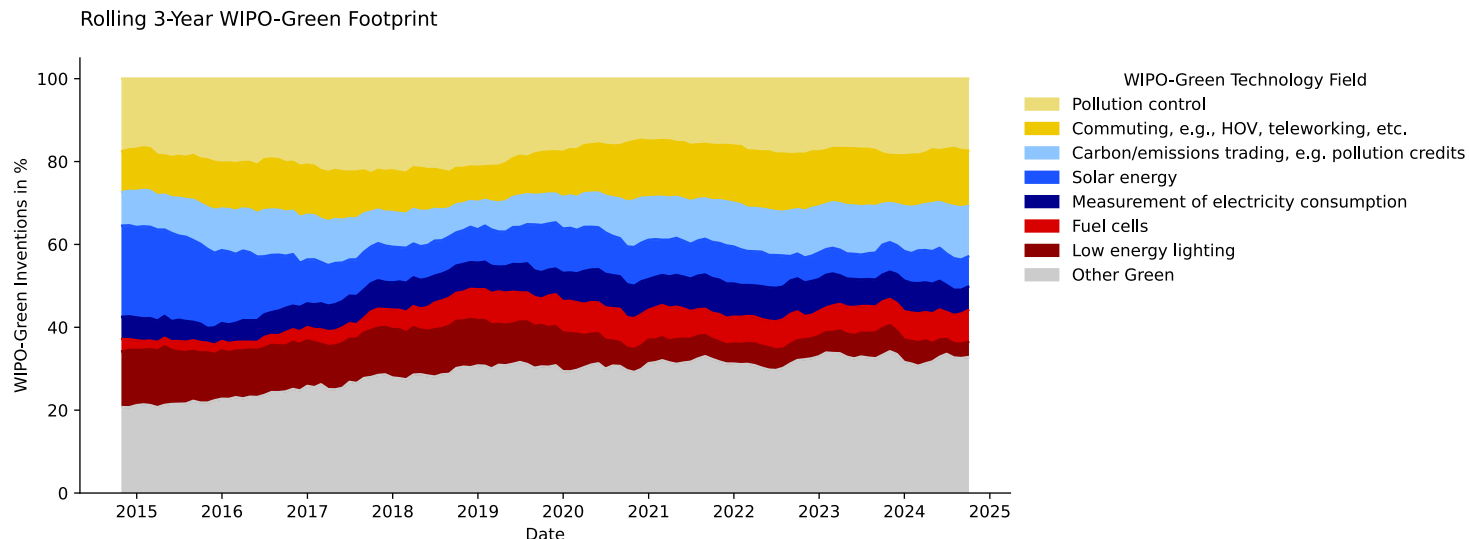
Rolling 1-Year Invention Count
