GROUND MILKING COMPETITION

Open to all Dairy breeds - Conducted along the rules set out by the RNA with the exception that lactation points are not taken into account. Animals entered in the Ground Milking Classes must also be entered in an Open Class. Animals will not be eligible for a prize if butterfat content average is less than 3.3% mass.

Entry time: All cows entered in these classes are to be on the ground no later than 4:00pm Wednesday, 27th May 2026. To be milked by 6:00pm that day. Milking at 6:00am and 6:00pm Thursday 28th May 2026.
