The following items have been fixed:

Case	Description
24515	An issue was identified where changing a product on a folio did not update the associated revenue group correctly. The system now automatically applies and updates the correct revenue group based on the newly selected product, ensuring accurate financial handling.
24532	Previously, parts of the screen appeared cut off , making the information difficult to read. Although users could scroll to view the hidden content, this behavior was unintended. The screen now displays correctly, ensuring all information is fully visible.
24562	An issue where the booker's last name was truncated has been resolved. Last names are now displayed properly.
24600	An issue that caused an error message to appear when adding a consolidation date or comments to POS products on the proforma screen has been resolved.
24675	SiteMinder: we observed an issue where we exceptionally received a reservation XML with the total amount for the entire stay instead of the nightly rate we normally receive. SiteMinder processes reservations based on the capabilities of the connected booking channel and the PMS, so the XML format can vary while still containing the same reservation information. We improved our logic to correctly process this type of reservation, ensuring that reservations are handled correctly regardless of whether the total stay amount or nightly rates are provided.
24718	Cubilis: we improved our logic with Cubilis to support updating the restriction Min LOS Thr and Max LOS Thr when receiving updates for this restriction from revenue management systems.
24756	RevControl: when publishing pricing updates from RevControl for a long period, a large amount of pricing data needs to be sent to the channel manager. To improve the reliability of these updates, the data is now divided into smaller groups before being sent. If one of these groups cannot be processed immediately, it is automatically retried. This reduces the risk of failed price updates and helps ensure that long-range pricing from RevControl is published successfully.
24783	Last week we fixed an issue related to case 24521, however we noticed that the Program tab continued to display a count indicating an active program even when all programs were cancelled. The indicator now correctly reflects the count and is no longer showing a count when there are no active programs.
