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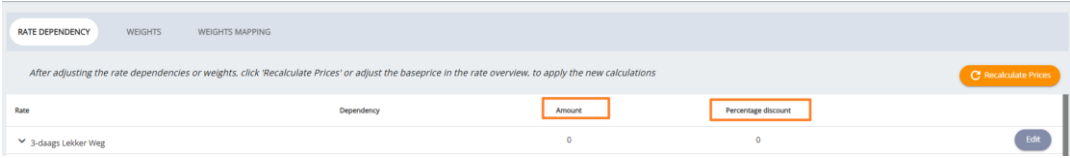
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This document contains a list of all improvements implemented today. We, the VIPS CloudPMS team, are constantly working to improve and update the application. We can't do this without your help. Thank you!

The following items have been fixed:

Case	Description
16582	When assigning an existing contact as an Alternative Contact from the summary invoice screen, some fields were missing from the available options. This issue has been resolved, and the relevant fields and detail sections are now displayed as expected.
20840	PayByLink: In the PayByLink integration payment mapping configuration, PSP payments that have already been mapped to a PMS payment type were still appearing in the PSP Payment dropdown. This has been corrected. Once a PSP payment is mapped to a PMS payment type, it is no longer available for selection in the dropdown, preventing the same PSP payment from being mapped again.
22073	In Yield Management Rate Configurations, the absolute and relative values configured in the Rate Dependencies field were no longer visible in the overview. This issue has been resolved, and the configured values are now displayed correctly. In addition, the labels have been updated for improved clarity: • Absolute Value → Amount • Relative Value → Percentage Discount 
23525	We have improved the logic for deactivating products that are still in use in configurations, such as Bookingsplans . The system now better identifies when a product is actively used and ensures the user is appropriately informed before deactivation. This helps prevent configurations from becoming incomplete or invalid when a mandatory product is still in use. The validation has been improved to provide a more consistent experience across the different scenarios where a product is used in a configuration.
24787	In Yield Management Rate Configurations , the Weight Scheme configured in the Weights setting was previously removed when the Weight Scheme name was updated. As a result, the associated weights were also lost. This has been resolved. Users can now update the Weight Scheme name without losing the associated weights. The scheme name is updated accordingly, including in the grid, while all existing weight configurations are retained.
25176	In Communication Templates , we observed that the Program and Group M&E Products block objects were not being displayed correctly. This has been resolved. Both block objects are now displayed and work as expected.
