

Where applicable this role will see the supervisor undertaking CDM duties as principal contractor or supporting the appointed principal contractor with monitoring and audits throughout the construction phase and ensuring all health and safety procedures are adhered to. Our deployment program is focused on providing exceptional customer experience from day one.

Responsibilities

- Ensure Safety is put first at on-site installations and during maintenance.
- Supervise the installation of our charge points, including hardware, software and Service, Maintenance & Repair requirements as per the CDM duties of principle contractor
- Site inductions, setting to work, reviewing RAMs and provide toolbox talks.
- Leasing with third-party contractors, to deliver quality, on time and at the agreed cost.
- Development and delivery of commercially viable EV charging solutions at pace and in line with our wider goals and objectives.
- Support the Operations and Technical Directors and other local/regional stakeholders to develop the deployment strategy and lead the technical implementation of sites within your region.
- Reporting on the progress of sites and installations within remit.
- Site surveys/capable of concept designs & site selection.
