The meeting was opened with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Malczewski made the motion, and Councilman Macaluso seconded the motion to approve the minutes from the March 18, 2026 and March 26, 2026, meeting. Ayes-4. Noes-0. Abstain-1. (Councilman Kupczyk abstained) Carried.

Making the legal notice for the Public Hearing on a Preliminary Business Use Permit for Todd Huber 6177 Seneca St, Elma NY for a conversion from a two-unit dwelling to a four-unit dwelling, under Town Code 144-141. Supervisor Clark opened the public hearing at 7:01 pm. Speaking against the project Robert Gross at 11 Northrup. No one spoke for the project. Supervisor Clark closed the public hearing at 7:03 pm.

Department Reports:

Building Inspector Joseph Colern presented the monthly building report for March 2026 with 22 permits issued, fees collected of \$5,834.21 with an estimated value of construction of \$2,909,900.00.

Deputy Water Superintendent DJ Thompson gave thanks to all that helped during the major water break on Tuesday April 7th, 2026, that affected the whole Town of Elma.

Deputy Highway Superintendent Michael Malecki noted that rubbish pick up is completed and brush pick up starts Monday, April 20, 2026. A tub grinding demo will be presented at the Transfer Station and the Town Board is welcome to attend, date to be announced. Also, the Highway department will be starting their four (4) ten (10) hour day summer schedule.

Councilman Kupczyk made the motion, and Councilman Malczewski seconded the motion to add and item to the agenda. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Kupczyk made the motion, and Councilman Macaluso seconded the motion to approve the purchase of a KM International 4-Ton Asphalt Hot Box/Reclaimer Dump Trailer at the cost of 45,760 for the Highway Department. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Nolan made the motion, and Councilman Kupczyk seconded the motion to approve a Business Use Permit for Fitness with Lees" LLC at 2329 Bowen Rd, Elma NY for functional and adaptive personal training and lifestyle planning. Councilman Macaluso made the motion, and Councilman Kupczyk seconded the motion to award the old highway garage roof bid to Innovative General Contracting with option B at the cost of \$171,5020. (option A \$165,200). Bids from United Precision Construction Services LLC option A \$287,620. and option B \$291,780; Building Solutions General Contractor option A \$201,950 and option B \$209,450 and Sturm Roofing LLC option A \$187,500, and option B \$193,200. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Macaluso made the motion, and Councilman Nolan seconded the motion to approve the quote to remove the roof trusses from the old highway garage to United Precision Construction Services LLC at the cost of \$6,900. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Kupczyk made the motion, and Councilman Macaluso seconded the motion to approve the Summer Concert Series every Wednesday from July 1st to August 26th, 2026. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Nolan made the motion, and Councilman Macaluso seconded the motion to approve the dog warden Emily Marks to attend a dog control education seminar at the cost \$180.in Webster NY. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilman Nolan made the motion, and Councilman Kupczyk seconded the motion to go out to bid for the replacement doors for the Senior Center. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.


