PAYMENT DEADLINE: Exhibits are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the exhibit hall is sold out, companies can be added to a waitlist in the event of a cancellation. Upon acceptance, RISE will secure exhibit space once payment is finalized. All payments must be received by September 2, 2026. While payment is not required at the time of application, it must be settled by the deadline to maintain your reservation.

CANCELLATION POLICY: A full refund will be issued to the Exhibitor only if written notice is received by September 2, 2026. Cancellation requests must be submitted to TRAINING@ANIHOUSTON.COM no later than this date to be eligible for a refund. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made after September 2, 2026.

RISE *terms & conditions*

Defined Terms

- a) The term "RISE" refers to Regenerative. Innovation. Science. Entrepreneurship, and includes its officers, directors, staff, agents, and representatives.
 - b) The term "RISE Summit" refers to the 2026 Summit displaying regeneration, innovation, science, and entrepreneurship, taking place October 2-3, 2026, in Houston, Texas.
 - c) The term "Exhibitor" refers collectively to any company or individual that has applied for and been accepted to participate in the RISE Summit sponsorship or exhibition program.
- Any violation of these Terms and Conditions by an Exhibitor or its representatives may result in immediate removal from the event space. In such cases, no refunds will be issued, and the Exhibitor waives any right to claims or compensation against RISE.

Exhibitor Qualifications

RISE Summit management reserves full discretion in determining eligibility for participation. Exhibitors must offer products or services that align with the medical, aesthetic, professional, or business objectives of the RISE Summit.

RISE reserves the right to:

- Decline any applicant not aligned with the event's standards, vision, or audience
- Limit participation based on capacity
- Ensure all exhibitors reflect the elevated nature and mission of RISE

Compliance & Conduct

All Exhibitors are expected to operate with professionalism and integrity.

- a) Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited within all event spaces.
- b) Outside alcohol may not be brought into or distributed within the event.
- c) RISE reserves the right to remove any exhibit, display, or representative deemed:
 - Non-compliant
 - Disruptive
 - Misaligned with the mission and standards of the Summit
- d) Removal for misconduct results in:
 - Immediate forfeiture of all fees
 - Continued liability for any damages caused
- e) Booth sharing or subletting is strictly prohibited.
- f) No-Show Policy:
Failure to set up and staff a booth by the official opening time without prior approval will result in:
 - Loss of booth space
 - No refunds or credits
 - Reassignment of space at RISE's discretion
- g) Suitcasing is strictly prohibited.
Soliciting business outside of designated exhibit areas (aisles, hotel spaces, other booths) is not permitted.
- h) Audio & Entertainment Guidelines:
 - Must receive prior written approval
 - Must comply with copyright licensing requirements
 - Must not exceed acceptable sound levels or disrupt surrounding exhibitors or sessions
- i) Educational Integrity (CME Compliance):
RISE maintains strict separation between education and promotion.
 - Exhibits must not influence educational content.
 - Promotional materials are not permitted in educational sessions
 - Sales activity is prohibited within educational rooms
 - Exhibitors must clearly disclose the FDA status of any products displayed

Communications Consent

By participating, Exhibitors consent to receive event-related communications via email and text from RISE.

Media & Content Release

Exhibitors grant RISE full permission to capture and use:

- Photography
- Video
- Audio

for marketing, promotional, and public-facing purposes across digital and print platforms.

Exhibit Space & Placement

- a) Exhibit space is considered reserved only upon acceptance and full payment.
 - Platinum & Gold Sponsors: Priority placement
 - All Other Sponsors: Assigned based on availability and timing of payment
- b) Payment deadlines will be outlined in the Sponsorship Agreement. Failure to meet deadlines may result in cancellation of space unless otherwise approved.
- c) RISE reserves the right to:
 - Adjust floor plans
 - Reassign booth locations
 - Optimize layout for overall event experience
- d) Inclusion in printed materials and event listings is dependent on the timely submission and approval of sponsorship materials.

Final Authority

These Terms and Conditions are binding and form part of the official agreement between the Exhibitor and RISE. Any matters not explicitly addressed herein remain subject to the final decision of RISE Summit management.

RISE *terms & conditions*

Payment Policy

Payment is not required at the time of application. However, to secure exhibit space and inclusion in official RISE Summit materials, full payment must be received by the deadline outlined in the Sponsorship Agreement.

Accepted payment methods may include check, money order, ACH, Zelle, or credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express). All payments are processed through the RISE Summit administration.

Cancellation by Exhibitor

Written cancellations submitted by the stated deadline are eligible for a refund minus a \$100 administrative fee. After this deadline, all payments are non-refundable and non-transferable.

RISE is not responsible for the inclusion of cancelled Exhibitors in previously produced materials.

Cancellation by RISE

If RISE is unable to host the event due to circumstances beyond its control, the Exhibitor's sole remedy is a full refund of payments made.

Failure to meet payment deadlines may result in termination of participation. Exhibitors with outstanding balances may be denied setup or access.

Relocation & Event Modifications

RISE reserves the right to rename, reschedule, or relocate the event. If changes occur within the same city or within a 30-day window of the original dates, no refunds will be issued. Exhibitors will be reassigned comparable space and agree to these terms.

Insurance & Contractors

Exhibitors must maintain property and general liability insurance of at least \$1,000,000, along with required workers' compensation coverage.

Exhibitor Appointed Contractors must carry equivalent insurance and comply with all RISE Terms & Conditions. Exhibitors are responsible for their contractors.

Exhibit Space & Services

Each Exhibitor will receive one 6-foot table and two chairs. All displays must remain within the assigned space.

Additional services such as electricity, internet, and décor must be arranged directly with the venue.

RISE does not provide security. Exhibitors are responsible for their own materials at all times.

Promotional Disclaimer

RISE is not liable for errors or omissions in attendee lists, marketing materials, digital platforms, or printed assets. This includes any inclusion of canceled exhibitors.
