


## Your January update

### Exhibitor Staff Passes

Exhibitor passes will be allocated and available to purchase in early February. Passes will be supplied as a digital pass with a scannable QR code. The pass can either be printed or presented on your phone for scanning on each event day when you enter the site. The main contact for your site will be sent a link to manage your allocated exhibitor passes within our ticketing system Flicket. Within Flicket you will be able to send out passes to staff and be able to track what tickets are allocated or have not been redeemed by the person you have allocated them to. Our exhibitor hub includes a helpful how-to video to help make this process as easy as possible..
