PHYS1900 will earn transfer credit for PHYS1XXX, which will count as a substitution (not equivalent) for RDP's PHYS1205 and as a pre-requisite for PHYS1226 which you will take at RDP.

Admission information for transferring to Red Deer Polytechnic:

- a) Transfer students can be admitted to any RDP academic term:
 - a. Fall: September to December
 - b. Winter: January to April
 - c. Spring: May to June
 - d. Summer: July to August
- b) RDP guarantees admission to the BSc Biology, BA Psychology, and BA Multidisciplinary Studies programs as a transfer student provided that the applicant from Bow Valley College meets the following requirements:
 - a. English language proficiency requirements as detailed in the RDP academic calendar
 - b. A cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher on all transfer courses
 - i. Failing and non-transferable grades (i.e. D or D+) will be considered as attempts and used to calculate the GPA.
 - ii. Non-credit courses do not count towards the GPA.
