

University Transfer students can choose from a variety of courses to create a path towards a future degree at a post-secondary institution of their choice*. You can complete courses towards a Bachelor of Social Work degree here at Bow Valley College.

Bachelor of Social Work at University of Calgary

The University of Calgary's admission requirements for BSW are provided here: <u>Social</u> Work | Future Students | University of Calgary

The University of Calgary requires post-secondary transfer students to **57 units** of university transferable non-social work courses. This is the equivalent **of 19 Bow Valley College courses**. You can choose any 19 of the courses offered in University Transfer.

The Social Work program also requires applicants to have English 30-1 or a post-secondary English course. You can take **ENGL1302 Literature and Society** to fulfill this requirement. This will be one (1) of your 19 courses.

*Each post-secondary institution and program has its own entry requirements. Completing courses at Bow Valley College through University Transfer will not guarantee admission to these programs. Students still need to apply to the university of their choice.
