Introducing Bob Hope Companion Services

Bob Hope Companion Services is a new offering created to enhance the quality of life for our residents by providing additional support beyond our regular transportation offerings. This program begins by offering extended transportation to medical appointments outside our standard driving area for a fee of approximately \$30 per hour (2-hour minimum).

As we grow, so will the services—future enhancements to the program will include light housekeeping, companionship, assistance with technology, and help with completing everyday tasks. Our goal is to evolve Bob Hope Companion Services to meet the changing needs of our residents and support their independence every step of the way.

All service require a 48 hour notice for scheduling.

- ♦ Transportation/Errands outside of Bob Hope Village driving area
- ♦ Laundry/Housekeeping
- ♦ Companionship/Emotional Support
- ♦ Grocery Shopping
- ♦ Arranging Appointments

More services will be offered as we grow.





- Damaged Electronics
- Poor Air Quality




