Maintenance Notes & Updates

February 2026

It looks like a cold month ahead. With that in mind, remember here in Florida we use heat pumps versus the old furnace from up north. When the heat pump cannot keep up, the system activates backup electric strips.

On-campus projects:

Walking trail is getting one more layer of glue, then it will be 100% complete. During the Spring, the maintenance team will spread seeds or lay sod on the edges to make it more detailed. Advance Concrete will start the Commons pool deck resurfacing sometime in February. I will give plenty of notice so that folks can schedule another type of workout.

I have ordered some more Jasmine for the Village 5 courtyards. Hopefully, the Spring weather will allow them to spread like wildfire.

Unit inspections will continue. We are looking to ensure the units are safe, functional, and clean but lived in. Examples are foyers being clear, no fire hazards,


