Natomas Reach A Levee Repairs, Sacramento, CA

- \$113M project widening the existing levee through construction of an adjacent levee
- 3.5 miles of DMM cut-off wall to a maximum depth of 145 ft.
- 132,700 cy of excavation and 466,950 cy of fill
- Replacement of gate, crack repair of conduit, Tremie grouting
- Repaving and restriping of new pavement



Folsom Dam Raise Mormon Island Auxiliary Dam Project, Folsom Lake , CA

- Construction of SCCB cutoff wall and floodwall to control seepage
- Placement of these walls will fall along the centerline of the dam's existing central core
- Wind-wave erosion protection using riprap along the upstream slope
