

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

The Eternal Son of God

John 1:1-14

1. Read John 1:1–4. What do you notice about the way John connects Jesus (the Word) with creation? How do these verses shape the way we understand Jesus identity?
2. Read John 1:5. The Greek word ‘katalambanō’ can be translated ‘overcome’ or ‘comprehend’. What do you find most difficult to comprehend about Jesus? Where do you see people trying to put out the light of Christ and yet Jesus keeps shining bright?
3. Read John 1:9–13. John says some people did not “recognise” or “receive” Jesus, even though He created them. Why do you think it was hard for people to recognise God when He came in human form? What can we do today to help people see the light of Christ in the world?
4. John describes Jesus as “the true light that gives light to everyone” (John 1:9). Where do you personally feel in need of God’s light right now—clarity, comfort, direction, hope?

5. John says that those who believe in Jesus are given the right to become children of God (John 1:12). What does being God's child mean to you at this point in your faith journey?
6. John teaches that Jesus is not an impersonal force but a person who invites us into relationship. What is one simple practice this week that could help you grow that relationship—prayer, reading Scripture, slowing down, community, worship?
7. How would you like to grow in your relationship with God through this series in John?
8. If Jesus is the Word made flesh (John 1:14)—the One who shows us what God is really like—what is one area of life where you want to align more closely with His way of living this year (grace, truth, compassion, forgiveness, courage, love)?
