

## LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

# I AM the Resurrection and the Life

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1. Read John 11:1-6. Jesus hears that Lazarus is sick but *delays* going to him. How does this part of the story challenge or expand your understanding of God's timing?
2. Read John 11:33-36. Jesus is "deeply moved" and He weeps. What does this moment reveal about the humanity of Jesus? How does this scene help us hold together both His divinity (Exodus 3:14; John 1:1-4) and His compassion?
3. Martha and Mary both say, "Lord, if You had been here..." (John 11:21, 32). Can you relate to moments where you felt God was "too late" or absent? What did that experience reveal about your expectations of God and your trust in His ways?
4. Jesus responds to Martha with truth and to Mary with grace. Where in your own life right now, do you feel you need Jesus' truth, His grace, or both? Why?
5. Jesus asks Martha, "*Do you believe this?*" (John 11:26). What would it look like for you to live this week as if Jesus truly holds "the keys of life and death" (Revelation 1:18)? How might that change your decisions, fears, or priorities?

6. In John 11, Jesus confronts death with both compassion and authority. How can we reflect Jesus' balance of grace and truth in our relationships, especially with people who are grieving, struggling, or questioning faith?
