

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

Sent By Jesus

John 20: 19 - 23

1. Read **John 20:21**. Jesus says, “As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.” Looking at Jesus’ life, what was he sent by the Father to do, and what might that show us about what it means for his followers to be sent today?
2. When you think about Jesus being sent to show God’s love, bring hope and draw people back to the Father, where have you personally experienced his love or hope in your own life?
3. Read **Matthew 25:14–30**. In the parable, the servants are entrusted with different amounts and asked to be faithful with what they have. How are you investing what God has entrusted to you, such as your skills, gifts, resources or opportunities, and is there anything you may be hiding away that God is asking you to invest?
4. Being faithful to God’s call can involve sacrifice, faith and moving beyond comfort. What is one area where God may be inviting you to trust him more deeply in this season?
5. Going beyond is the heart of Jesus. Have you sensed God calling you to GO beyond in this Gateway Beyond season? If so, what has he been saying? What is one simple, practical step you could take this week to join in Jesus’ mission where you live, work, study or serve?
6. Read **John 14:12-14**. Jesus invites his followers to pray in his name so the Father is glorified. What is one prayer you are praying for your church, your neighbourhood, or someone who needs to encounter Jesus? Pray boldly together as a group for these prayers.
