Presented in iconic Rosso Corsa over Crema Leather, this Ferrari 328 GTS is an exceptional example in true concours condition. The paintwork remains in outstanding shape across all panels, with paint depth readings consistent with original factory specifications. Importantly, there are no signs of overspray on the sills or trims, indicating the car retains its original paint and has not undergone any repair work.

All Ferrari badges are in excellent condition, and the engine bay is adorned with a Crepaldi Autos tag — a nod to its Italian origins. While this 328 is not currently Ferrari 'Classiche Certified', there is every reason to believe it would qualify for certification, given its originality and condition. The car benefits from a comprehensive history file and has been meticulously maintained in the UK by renowned Ferrari specialist Bob Houghton.

It also retains the complete original Ferrari tool kit. All UK taxes have been paid, and the vehicle is registered with only two previous keepers.

This 328 GTS has enjoyed a pampered existence, living in private collections in both Italy and the UK. Since 2023, under the care of TheCarCrowd, it has been stored in a secure, temperature-controlled, and dehumidified facility in the East Midlands. The car is brought up to operating temperature twice per quarter and driven 5-10 miles annually solely for maintenance, always in dry conditions.


During the winter months, the vehicle is preserved further by being run on an indoor rolling road, ensuring it remains in top mechanical condition without exposure to the elements. Maintenance has continued through trusted Ferrari specialists, and the car is preserved using STA-BIL concentrated storage fuel. It will be supplied to the next owner with a fresh service from a Ferrari main dealer or marque specialist.

This particular 328 GTS was most recently showcased at the prestigious Concours of Elegance 2024 held at Hampton Court Palace - a testament to its standout quality and provenance.



The engine bay is in pristine condition reflecting the low mileage and careful maintenance by previous owners. It shows no signs of wear or damage and its original, unmodified factory configuration


