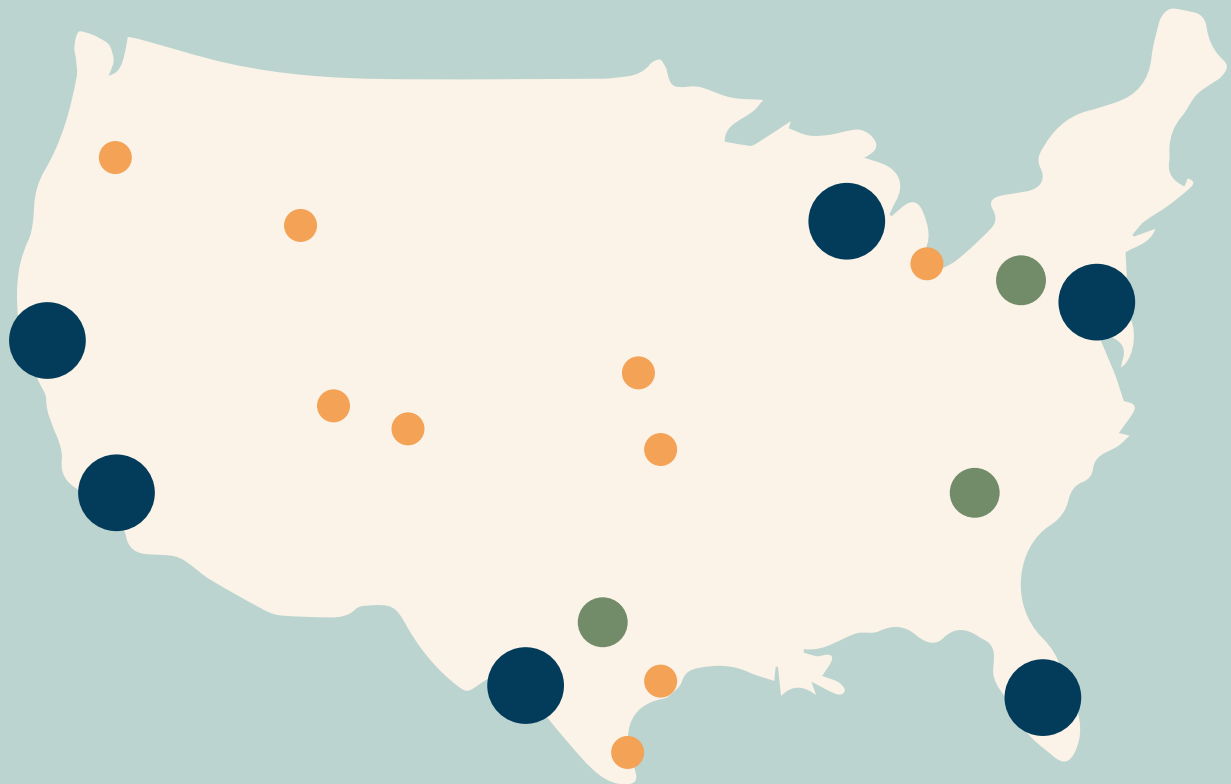

PATHFINDER BY THE NUMBERS

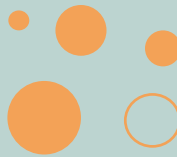
In April 2025, we conducted a statistical analysis of 5,782 cases while conducting a survey alongside The California Access to Justice Commission to analyze the feedback of our 100 first users. The results:

A letter from our CEO

Dear Pathfinders,

As immigration practitioners face a hurricane of change, one thing is clear: we must meet chaos with clarity. We cannot falter in unpredictability and must remain steadfast in our mission to provide certainty, direction, and hope.

Since 2023, our data initiative has collected hundreds of millions of records on immigrants in court, a resource so rich and comprehensive that it has garnered widespread media recognition. This was no small feat and unlocks the potential of our AI tools like Pathfinder. As Pathfinder's data shows – by alerting our users with timely, actionable data – we achieve fewer deportations.

These alerts are needed now more than ever. As our government unites a mass deportation machine, we must unite the mass opportunity machine.

To achieve this vision, Mobile Pathways and our partner network must leverage this ocean of data to build the next frontier in immigration law.
