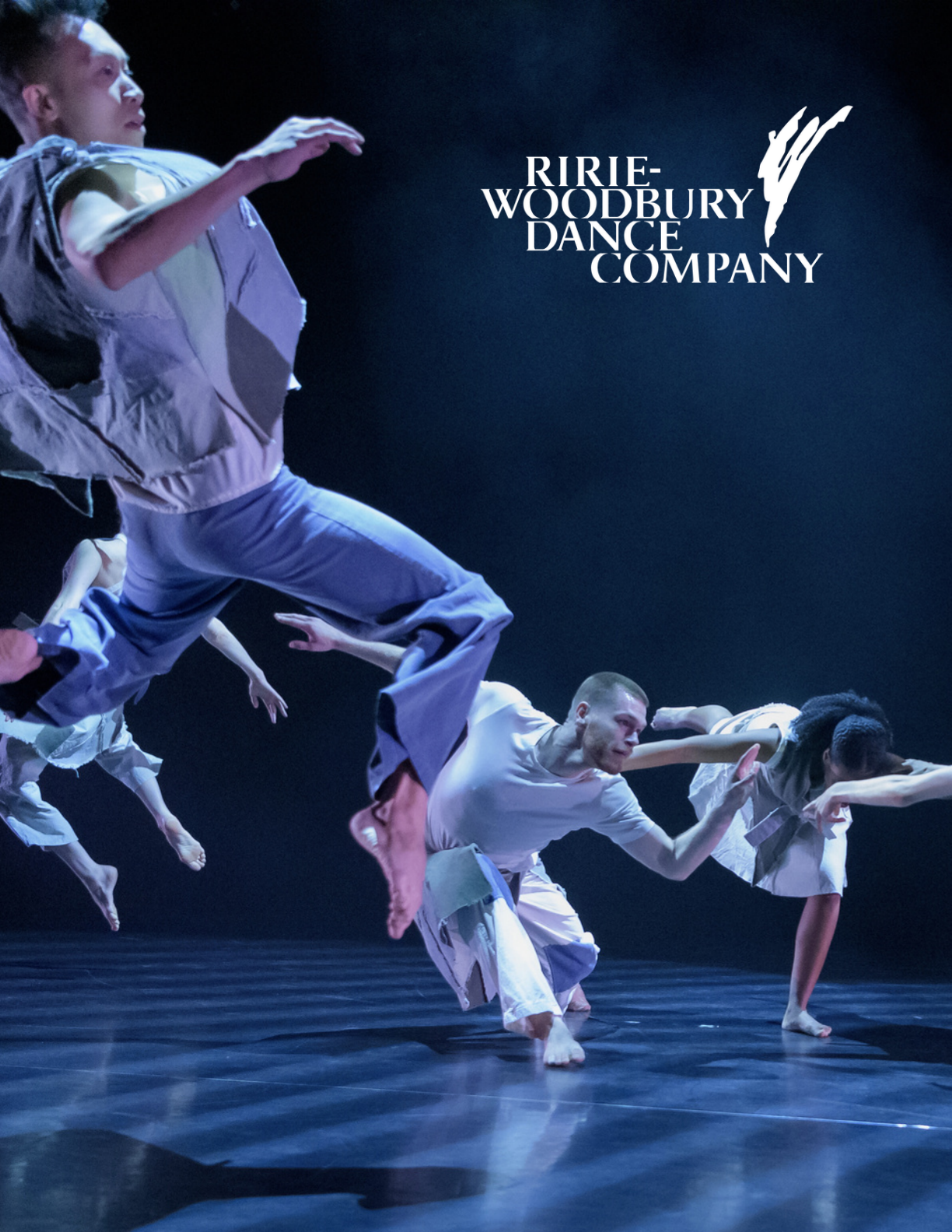

Ririe-Woodbury Dance Company, founded in 1964 by Joan Woodbury and Shirley Ririe, is Utah's longest-standing international contemporary dance institution.

Guided by the motto "dance is for everybody," the Company commissions bold new works and offers education programs that make dance accessible to all ages and backgrounds. Over six decades, RWDC has performed across the U.S. and worldwide, including a landmark partnership with the Nikolais/Louis Foundation.

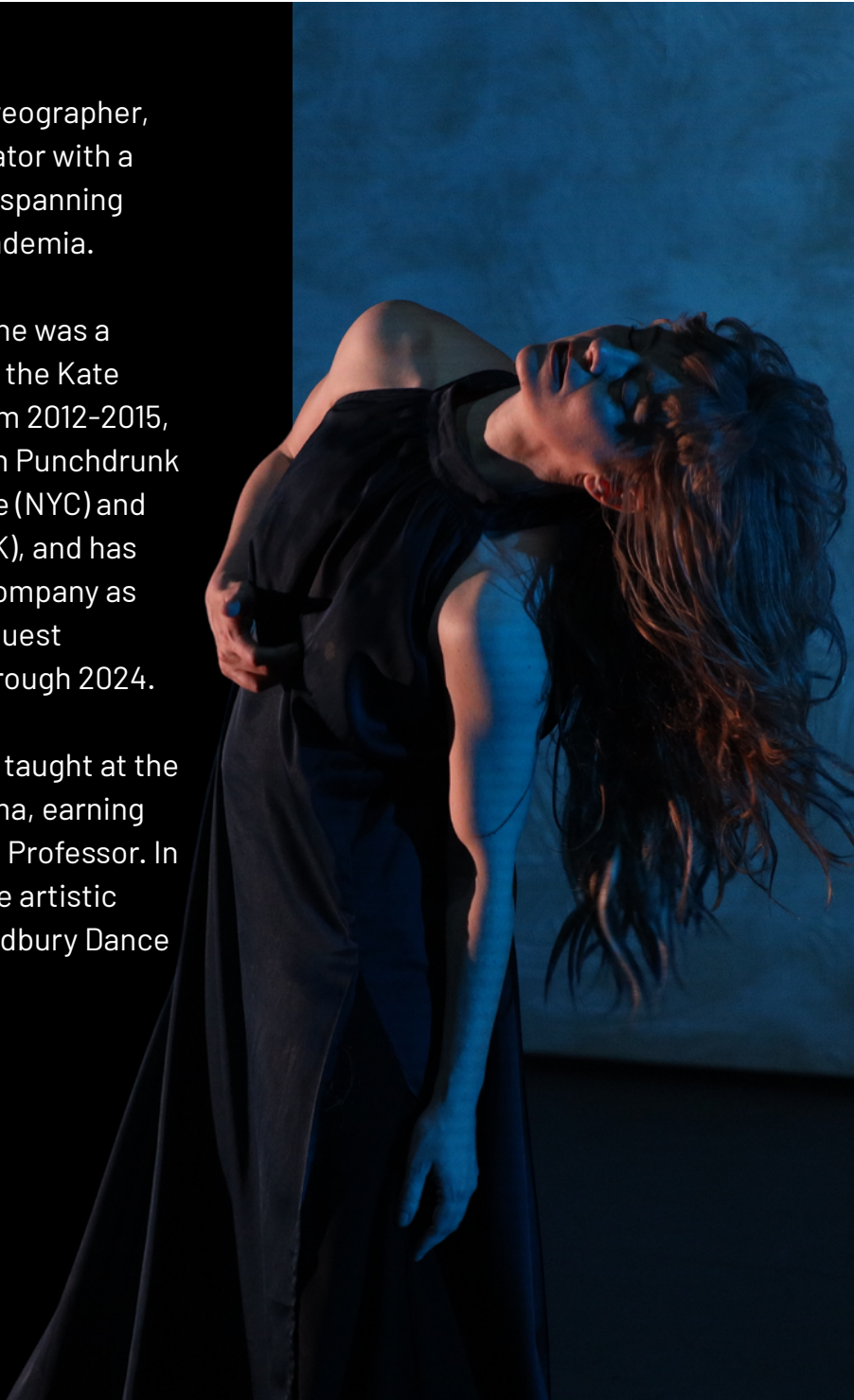
Today, under the Artistic Direction of Leslie Kraus, RWDC continues to champion innovation, community, and the transformative power of dance.

LESLIE KRAUS - ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Leslie Kraus is a choreographer, performer, and educator with a distinguished career spanning performance and academia.

From 2006 to 2014, she was a principal dancer with the Kate Weare Company. From 2012-2015, Kraus performed with Punchdrunk in both *Sleep No More* (NYC) and *The Drowned Man* (UK), and has continued with the company as both performer and guest rehearsal director through 2024.

From 2018-2025, she taught at the University of Oklahoma, earning the rank of Associate Professor. In 2025, she became the artistic director of Ririe-Woodbury Dance Company.



Sarabande for 6 by Annie Rigney

Sarabande for 6 is a visceral exploration of emotion, relationships, and human complexity. Through rich, sensory, image based movement, the work invites audiences into an intimately embodied experience. In the round or proscenium.



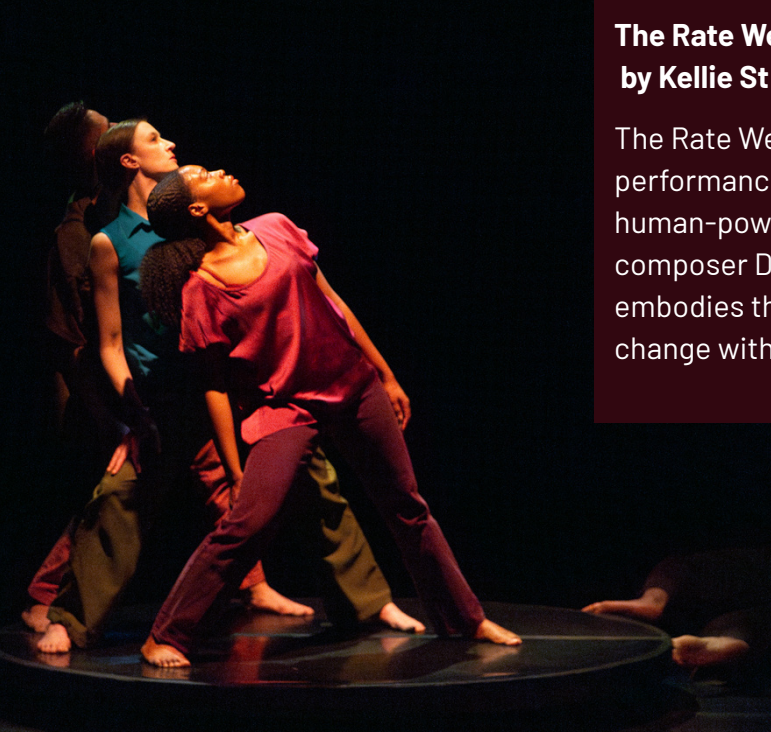

The Opposite of Killing explores anger, sorrow, and understanding through improvisation, dynamic phrase work, and theatrical imagery. Costumes transition from dark to light gray, darkness to hope. Accommodates six additional dancers.

PRESERVING THE WORKS OF ALWIN NIKOLAIS



Ririe-Woodbury Dance Company is the only company worldwide with rights to perform full evenings of Alwin Nikolais' groundbreaking works.

Called the "father of multi-media theater," Alwin Nikolais was an American choreographic master who designed every element of his productions (lighting, sound, costumes, movement, props) into his signature striking geometric style. His groundbreaking vision profoundly shaped generations of choreographers and companies.

Alongside Nikolais Foundation Artistic Director Alberto del Saz, RWDC has toured these legacy works internationally since 2003, and remains committed to preserving Nikolais' legacy while continuing to expand its contemporary repertory.
