Did you know that this classic vessel is the main scene for international explorer TV series running in 20 countries?

MS Tromsø (Fjord Visjon) has license to sail with upto 70 passengers and host 28 guests overnight in cosy small cabins. There is a northern lights bar on the upper deck that are known by locals for being the best spot in Tromsø watching the northern lights during the evening & where we dock. You are welcome to try it with a hot soup or maybe a Tromsø beer or drink in your hand.



Did you know that royalties from many countries in Europe have been sailing expeditions on this boat?

You might wonder why because there is no luxury here, but maybe thats a part of the answer ... The Captain can tell you the secret if you ask.

The boat have a project where we harvest seaweed that destroy Co2 and make healthy energy drinks from the remainings with natural vitamins protecting your immune defence. The remainings after the remainings will be distilled into bio fuel to run the boat. If you want to know more get in touch with The crew. Did you know that it was polarbears in the streets of Tromsø? Some came floating on ice flakes to check out whats goin on in The Arctic Capital (!) Even polarbear cubbs where brought to town by fishermen coming back from the polar ice. But cubes can grow ...



Talking about polarbears ... Our Russian neighbors do GPS jamming (disturbing boats satellite navigation) meaning that they polute our chart signals, so to be safe this vessel is also equipped with traditional paper charts and we do manual navigation plotting. Stop by the wheelhouse and we show you how it works.



There are 2 toilets in the reception area on the main deck and there are 3 more toilets on the lower deck down from the reception. Feel free to walk around the vessel and get the atmosphere of the expeditions. Depending on occupancy you can order food and drinks in the reception or also on the upper deck in the Northern lights bar.

Coffee & tea are free of charge as much as you want in the main saloon.

When do I see wildlife animals? Its impossible to predict but smale whales and sea eagels are around all the time, but can be difficult to watch in the dark, feel free to borrow a binocular from the wheel house and test it out. We have one for you!

Morning cruise 10 AM to 1 PM.

- A) Welcome by the captain followed by a safety instruction from the seamen
- B) Departure 10:15 to the north of Tromsø
- C) 10:30 -11:00 Speech about The Arctic Capital the animal wildlife and polar expeditions in the main saloon
- D) 11:00-12:00 Please visit the wheel house and have a taste of polar navigation
- E) 11:30 Bar for hot lunch and drinks open
- F) For you who sail only on the morning departure its time to go ashore 13:00



Full day cruise 10 AM to 4 PM

Continue your voyage!

Afternoon cruise 1 PM to 4 PM

- A) As we cruise further south and under the main Tromsø bridge towards Balsfjorden you will see the Tromsø main city centre gliding by on your right side and the main land on the left, and the city mountain Tromsdalstind & the gondola on the right.
- B) 13:25 we pas BUKTA (The bay) the southernmost point on The Tromsø island famous for the coolest beach in the arctic & we will pas as close we can.
- C) 13:30 we continue towards Eid to check if there are any kingcrabs to get
- D) 14:30 Polar stories by our seamen in the main saloon
- E) 16:00 back by the dock
- F) Please visit the wheelhouse anytime between 14:00 and 14:30.



Evening cruise 5 PM to 8 PM & feel free to stay further to watch the northern lights by the dock

After a quick introduction on the main deck its time to sail out in the dark dark polar night, to destination unknown. Where is the northern lights showing tonight? In the mean time the TV series about the boat are shown and there is a lecture about life in The Arctic Capital (and some tips)

As its completely dark during this trip you will discover the life in The Urban Arctic capital as it is. The navigation here is complicated and teams of 5 are invited by the crew to join the cockpit for a little stay. Please ask the crew.

When we are back in Tromsø 20:00 we suggest you stay more because the upper deck blends with the dark sea and the mountains and can give you the ultimate northern lights view. For you who are interested in the local life here in The Arctic Capital, you can also join the Captain on his walk to his favorite places in the evening from 8 PM onwards selected days, and we do jazz concerts with local young artistst every Saturday.

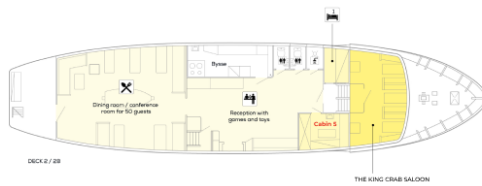
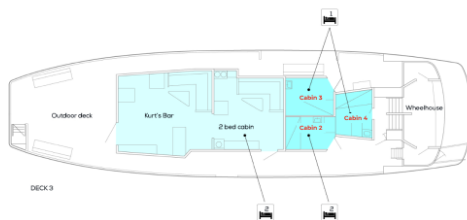
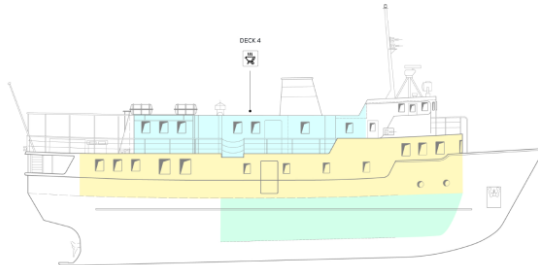
