

MARINA HSE & OPERATIONAL RULES

Signage and rules



Check for signs and announcements and adhere to the Marina rules. Respect signage for use of cars, scooters, bikes, skateboards or anything of similar nature, as well as speed limits.

Parking



Park only in designated parking areas.

Parking your car under a boat is strictly prohibited. The owner of the car shall be held responsible in case damage to boats, materials, buildings or people occur from this.



Noise

Be considerate with your noise levels. In case of excessive noise from another marina resident, please speak with the Marina's staff. The use of a generator is not allowed.



Open Fires

BBQs on boats and pontoons are always prohibited. BBQs onshore are only allowed in the designated area between 1 October and 30 April.



Sports and activities

Swimming, diving, fishing are not allowed within the Marina.



Children

Children under 14 must always be supervised. The parent or guardian is responsible for their care and safety.



Dogs and other animals

Keep your animals on leash and under control. They must not remain on boats unattended (unless permission is provided by the Marina). Owners are responsible for the fouls of their pets and must clean up and dispose of immediately. Check local regulations regarding muzzles.



Obstructions

All ancillary crafts (dinghies, wind surf boards, jet skis, and the like), equipment, gear and supplies must be kept on your boat or in the area provided, and not at pontoons or elsewhere in the Marina. Walkways must be kept clear to ensure safe passage. Our staff shall have the right to remove such craft, equipment, gear, or other supplies left unattended in the Marina. Always follow the instructions off the Marina staff.



Electrical safety

The boat owner or his representative shall take particular care to ensure that his shore-power connection is properly wired and connected. It is strictly prohibited to alter and/or modify the electrical pedestal. The owner shall be responsible for any damage caused to the electrical facilities due to poorly executed or negligent connections.



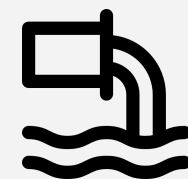
Shore-power leads and on-board mains electrical supplies must be maintained in good condition to avoid the risk of vessel fires. Dock handlers are instructed to disconnect and remove leads that have potential of posing a risk to others.

Power should be switched off prior to plugging and unplugging shore power leads from service pedestals and leads should never remain plugged into the pedestal alone. Leads should not hang in the water or create a trip hazard. Don't throw water on the pedestals while the cover is open. Cables should be disconnected when there is no one on board.



Washing boat parts

Washing and cleaning is only allowed with environmental friendly products, onboard and not on the docks. Car washing is prohibited.



Sewage, bilge water & waste lub oils

They must be exposed in the dedicated reception areas only.



Boating regulations

Respect boating regulations and conduct manoeuvring within applicable speed and wash limits.



General waste

Pay attention to environmental practices applied in this Marina. Use reception facilities for batteries, hazardous waste, general waste and recycling items.

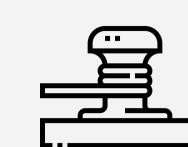


Pollution

The **discharge of sewage (emptying sewage holding tanks or boat toilets) into the waters of the Marina is strictly prohibited**, as is the use of boat toilets that are not connected to a sewage holding tank or an approved marine sanitation device. This prohibition is established under Greek maritime legislation and Port Regulations for the protection of the marine environment.

Violators are subject to strict administrative penalties, including substantial fines imposed by the competent Hellenic Port Authority.

If the marina personnel observe or become aware of any unlawful discharge of sewage, the incident will be reported immediately to the competent Port Authority for the appropriate enforcement action.



Mooring lines

Boat owners must ensure mooring lines are of a suitable material, condition and strength to provide security of the vessel in all anticipated weather conditions. Lines should be protected against chafe and replaced at the frequencies defined by rope manufacturers.



Fuel supply

The Marina does not have its own fuel station. In case fuel supply is required, please contact the Marina's staff to have this arranged. It is strictly prohibited to arrange a fuel truck on your own. The process will be overseen by the Marina's staff to ensure compliance with safety and environmental guidelines.



Maintenance and repairs

Major repairs, painting and fitting out of boats is prohibited. Please check with Marina office prior to engaging any contractor to ensure the work is permitted and for conditions that apply to the contractor / worker. Minor repairs, detailing, cleaning, non-spray painting and mechanical adjustments or electrical works will be permitted at the Marina provided that no nuisance or interference with, or fire risk to others using the Marina is caused by such work. Boat owners, family & friends, wishing to conduct own-boat repairs are bound by the same rules as contractors and must liaise with the Marina prior to beginning works.

All third party technicians and contractors must pass by the Marina's office before boarding a boat.



CCTV

For your own safety and the safety of the Marina Staff and property, the Marina is making use of CCTV.

The Marina is entitled to take appropriate measures to rectify any breach of the aforesaid rules, including reporting to the Competent Authorities, cancelling the contract, and imposing corresponding charges in accordance with the current price list.
