


INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF SURICAL GASTROENTEROLOGY – NEPALESE  
ASSOCIATION OF SURGICAL GASTROENTEROLOGY

CONFERENCE / COURSE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF SURICAL GASTROENTEROLOGY herein after called IASG being the First Party and ORGANISING COMMITTEE, NEPALESE ASSOCIATION OF SURGICAL GASTROENTEROLOGY (NASG) hereafter called OC being the Second Party, we, the first party and the Second Party hereby enter in MOU as per the following details.
2. Executive Committee (EC) of IASG shall be the authority to represent the **First Party**. President & Honorary Secretary of IASG shall carry out all instruction of the Executive Committee (EC) of IASG and is the authorized signatory of the First Party.
3. Objectives: The Parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:
  - a. Short-Term Fellowships
    - Facilitate short-term clinical and academic fellowship opportunities for members of NASG at IASG-affiliated centers.
    - Work on a framework later for long term fellowship programme.
    - Define fellowship duration, eligibility criteria, and application procedures through a mutually agreed supplementary guideline.
      - Two short term trainee will be selected by NASG per annum.
      - Post MS doctors with at least 3 years experience and or post Mch candidates are elligible to apply.
      - The candidates will be selected by interview by a panel identified by the NASG executive.
      - NASG will provide a stipend of 50,000 NRS per month for a duration of 3 months.
      - IASG will facilitate selection of and local logistics of the institute of the proposed training
    - The fellowship will be called "NASG IASG SHORT TERM TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP"
    - After the completion the fellow will be awarded a joint certificate.
    - The awardees are not permitted to use the association logos for their personal use and will continue to abide by intelectual property rules wherever applicable during and after the completion of the fellowship.



- b. Faculty Exchange During Conferences
- Support reciprocal faculty exchange for annual meetings, international congresses, and scientific events organized by either Party.
  - Promote joint symposia, lectures, and scientific sessions to enhance academic interaction.
- c. IASG Midterm Meeting in Kathmandu
- Explore the feasibility of hosting an IASG Midterm Meeting in Kathmandu, Nepal, in collaboration with NASG.
  - Form a joint working committee to assess logistics, scientific programming, and timelines for the proposed meeting.
4. Other conferences, courses and workshops in Kathmandu
- Explore the feasibility of hosting an IASG Midterm Meeting or other conferences in Kathmandu, Nepal, in collaboration with NASG.
  - Form a joint working committee to assess logistics, scientific programming, and timelines for the proposed meeting.
5. Responsibilities of the Parties
- a. IASG
- Provide academic and administrative support for fellowship placements.
  - Facilitate participation of IASG faculty in NASG conferences.
  - Collaborate with NASG on planning and executing the potential midterm meeting.
- b. NASG
- Nominate eligible candidates for fellowship opportunities.
  - Support logistical arrangements for visiting IASG faculty during NASG events.
  - Assist IASG in organizing the proposed midterm meeting in Kathmandu, including local coordination and government/ institutional liaison.
6. Implementation and Review
- The Parties shall appoint designated coordinators to oversee the implementation of activities under this MoU.
  - Progress and challenges may be reviewed annually or as agreed upon.
7. Duration and Termination
- This MoU shall remain valid for **five (5) years** from the date of signing and may be renewed upon mutual agreement.
  - Either Party may terminate this MoU upon **three (3) months' written notice** to the other Party.
8. General Provisions
- This MoU reflects the intentions of the Parties to collaborate but is **not legally binding**.



- Any specific programs or activities arising from this MoU may require separate agreements.
