

Visitor Guidelines

Welcome to Idaho Milk Enterprises Processing Plant. To help guarantee that we maintain the integrity of our products and to comply with Federal and Idaho state regulations, we require you to read and agree to follow the Good Manufacturing Processes (GMPs) listed below while you are in our plant.

- Watches and all jewelry must be removed (medical alert bracelets are exempt).
- All visitors must wear clean, appropriate clothing, including clean lab coats.
 - Shorts, capris, short skirts, open-toed shoes, and flip-flops are not allowed.
- Hairnets and beard nets shall always be properly worn to cover all loose hair.
- No items are permitted in pockets or hanging above the waist.
- Hearing protection must be worn in all production areas.
- Food and drink are not permitted (except in designated lunchroom areas).
- Hands must be washed thoroughly with soap for at least 20 seconds upon entering production areas.
- Gum is prohibited in the production, storage, or shipping areas.
- Tobacco use in any form is not permitted in the production facility.
 - There is a designated smoking area outside the facility.
- Personal belongings (including purses, briefcases, or cell phones) are not permitted in any production, processing, or storage areas, unless necessary to fulfill a designated job function.
- Cameras of any kind are not permitted in or around the entire facility.
- Firearms or other weapons are not permitted.
- Illegal drugs or substances are not permitted in or around our facilities.
- Alcohol consumption is not permitted in or around our facilities.
- Please be aware of slippery floors and vehicle traffic in the manufacturing area.
- Remain with a Company employee throughout your entire visit.
- Any items brought into the production area must be sanitized and inspected for any allergens or cross-contact.

Waiver and Release for Site Visit

I, the Releasor, being of lawful age, hereby sign this Waiver and Release for Site Visit. I understand that I am not allowed to participate in the site visit without first signing this Waiver and Release.

I release the Releasee from all liability, damages, or costs that might arise from participation in the visit, except those caused by the intentional or negligent acts of the Releasee.

1. Agreement for Voluntary Participation in Visit

I hereby confirm that I understand that I am participating in this visit voluntarily. My health is good, and I suffer no physical or mental conditions that render me particularly susceptible to injury or any disability while participating in a visit to the facility.

2. Understanding of Risk Involved

I am fully aware of all risks associated with my participation in this visit to a manufacturing facility. Risks include, without limitation, any injury arising from machinery, slippery floors, high noise levels, and exposure to hazardous chemicals. I agree to wear appropriate personal protective equipment, as Idaho Milk Enterprises may always require during my visit. I will conduct myself in a manner so as not to interfere with or impede the work of Idaho Milk Enterprises or others in the facility. I will avoid chemical storage areas and remain with a Releasee employee throughout my entire visit.

3. Acceptance of Risk and Assumption of Personal Responsibility

I accept and assume all risks in association with the visit offered by Idaho Milk Enterprises, whether they are foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown, in any way whatsoever associated with my participation in the visit offered by Idaho Milk Enterprises.

4. Release of Company from Liability

I hereby release Idaho Milk Enterprises, along with any affiliated entities or subsidiaries, current and former employees, officers, members, owners, managers, contractors, partners, directors, shareholders, or insurers (referred collectively to as the 'Released Entities') from all actions, claims, damages, losses, costs, liabilities, and expenses, including attorney's fees without limitation, for any loss or damage of property, injury, or death that arises in any way out of my participation in the visit, including, without limitation, all claims arising from the negligence of the 'Released Entities'.

5. Limitation of Damages

The liability of Idaho Milk Enterprises to me will be limited to actual damages caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the Released Entities while performing their duties and responsibilities hereunder. Idaho Milk Enterprises shall not be liable for any incidental, consequential, punitive, or special damage or any other form of direct or indirect damage, even if Idaho Milk Enterprises has been informed of the possibility thereof.

6. Indemnity from Claims

I agree to defend and indemnify the Released Entities from all claims of any kind incurred as a result of my participation in the Idaho Milk Enterprises visit.

7. Severability

If, for any reason, any provision of this waiver is declared to be unenforceable or invalid, the enforceability and validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected.

8. Governing Law and Venue

This waiver shall be governed by the laws of the State of Idaho, without regard to any conflict of principles of law. Venue shall be in Jerome County, Idaho.

9. Binding Effect

This waiver is binding upon my next of kin, family, heirs, personal representatives, beneficiaries, and assigns, and inures to the benefit of the Company, its assigns, and successors.

10. Confidentiality

While visiting the facility, I acknowledge that I may have access to Confidential Information, and I agree not to use, remove from Idaho Milk Enterprises premises, reproduce, disclose, or otherwise make any Confidential Information available without Idaho Milk Enterprises consent. "Confidential Information" means any information or materials of Idaho Milk Enterprises or its customers or employees that I observe or is disclosed to me in any format during my visit, including, without limitation, the set-up and design of testing equipment, processing equipment, Idaho Milk Product processes, tools, business and marketing plans, client samples and product information including names, identifying features, technical specifications, raw materials, testing phases and/or results. Contractors and other visitors may be required to separately agree to additional confidentiality obligations.

I UNDERSTAND THAT MY CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE OBLIGATION IS ONGOING AND IT DOES NOT END UPON TERMINATION OF MY RELATIONSHIP WITH THIS ESTABLISHMENT

THIS IS A WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY. I HAVE READ THE ENTIRE CONTENTS OF THIS DOCUMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE CEDED SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY AGREEING TO THE PROVISIONS IT CONTAINS.
