Workshop Title: Watercolor Collage Instructor Name: Kat Manton-Jones Dates: January 28, 2026, 9am-4pm

Location: Tubac Center of the Arts, 9 Plaza Road, Tubac, AZ, 85646

Optional: You may purchase a kit for this session. Price \$30. Includes watercolor paper substrates for mini collages (140#) and final collage (300#) cold press; Liquid acrylic glazing medium; Gesso; Yes! Paste; Craft Brushes; and Collage fodder. Participant is responsible for other items on the supply list.

Course: We will start with a brief demonstration. Everyone will have time to work on revitalizing a painting that is in need of rescue or to create an original work using abstract and experimental techniques with watercolor, gesso, and/or collage.

- Morning Sessions: Mini Collages; Idea exploration for Rescue Paintings; Rescue Painting Development with collage or begin scaling up an original work using a mini collage for inspiration
- Afternoon Session: Review and Completion of Rescue Painting or Collage; Mounting Collages; Closing Discussion with gentle self-critique of work and feedback if requested

Substrates:

- Mini-Collages (4) pieces of $5" \times 5"$ or (4) pieces of $3" \times 4"$ watercolor paper any weight
- Final Collage (1) 10" x 10" or (1) 9" x 12" Artist Panel or Canvas or 300# Watercolor Paper
- Optional: (1) painting that needs help/rescued/or something completely different. Any size.
- Collage Papers will be provided by the instructor. If you have special papers that you want to use for your project you may bring your own fodder.
- Sheet of Plexiglass 9" x 12"
- Stiff Board 9" x 12" for weighing down work
- Craft Paper
- Wax Paper

Tools:

- Exacto Knife, Scissors, or Rotary Cutter (the kind used for quilting)
- Cutting board, 9" x 12"
- Brayer
- Stencils or Stamps

Brushes for Adhesive and Gesso:

- For Adhesive: Stiff craft or nylon brushes or a plastic card, plastic putty spreader, or popsicle stick.

Brushes for Watercolor:

- This type of painting does not require fine (expensive) brushes.
- (2) Different sized 4, 6, 8, or 10 round watercolor brushes (inexpensive brands)
- (1) Size 1/2, 3/4 or 1-inch flats watercolor brushes (inexpensive brands)

Paints:

- Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid Satin Finish, 8 oz
- Golden Gesso White
- Watercolors Any colors and brand you own
- Water soluble crayons or pencils

Miscellaneous:

- Ecofriendly Reusable Towels or wash rag
