- Painting Panels solid panels are preferred for outdoors plan on at least 2 per day masonite 8x10, 9x12, 6x12 etc. (Nothing bigger than 12x16)

Tools:

- Easel You need a self contained painting setup
- Brushes- Princeton catalyst poly tip bristle.
- Flats #4 10. 12. 16. 20.
- Painting/Palette knife for mixing colors and painting
- Refined Linseed Oil
- Solvent Gamsol by Gamblin Turpinoid by Weber

Paints:

- Bring what you normally use everyday
- Optional: My Oil Paints are mostly 200ml Winton and Blick (See Below)

Blues; Cobalt Blue, French Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean blue

Greens; Viridian Green, Dark Verdigris Green, Permanent Green light

Yellows; Cadmium yellow Deep, Cadmium Yellow Pale

Reds; Permanent Rose, Cadmium Red Light Violet; Quinacridone Deep Pink (Magenta)

Earth Tones; Naples Yellow, Rosy Beige, Azo Yellow Green (Yellow Ocher)

White; Titanium White

Miscellaneous:

- Paper towels
- plastic bags for trash
- Sketch pad pencil/pen/gray value markers
- Wet panel holder
- hat/sunscreen/insect repellent chair/umbrella/water bottle cell phone charger
