TAPS Hot Lunch Support

Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House is a community service organization serving the Hastings-Sunrise community. **We are looking for patient and caring individuals who enjoy kitchen tasks, prepping and cooking** to assist our TAPS Hot Lunch Program staff to provide a healthy meal to our senior participants in a safe, friendly and supportive environment.

The Association of Neighbourhood Houses of BC (ANHBC)'s work is centered on inclusion and equity, to build social connection and to break down discrimination through community building. We strongly encourage applications from people who identify as Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour (BIPOC), individuals with disabilities, and members of the LGBTQIA2S+ communities.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Help with program set-up, prepping of meals, serving, clean-up and sanitize areas used in kitchen
- Engage with seniors, staff and other volunteers during program
- Problem-solve with the support from the team
- Record your volunteer hours
- Maintain confidentiality and security of all family's information

Benefits for applicants:

- Gain experience working in kitchen

- Learn about food security and better healthy eating practices
- Make a positive impact for seniors in the community
- Opportunity to learn new skills
- Improve communication skills while working with Senior Program staff and volunteers

Training & support provided:

- Comprehensive training on Covid protocols, sanitizing procedure, set up and closing of program.
- Kitchen Support orientation will be provided during volunteering time at the program and Kitchen Orientation for Frog Hollow will be available via invite.
- Debrief and feedback about Kitchen Support is provided after the program or seasonally.

Qualifications:

- Interest and/or experience in working in kitchen;
- Can demonstrate patience, empathy and enthusiasm;
- Additional language competencies beyond English is an asset;
- Food safe certificate is an asset;
- Have good verbal communication and listening skills;
- A strong attention to detail;
- Proven ability to work interdependently in a collaborative environment with colleagues in a small team environment;
- Successful completion of criminal record check.
