Effects of Dogmatism, Stigma, and Culture on Depression Symptoms in the Religious and Nonreligious

Advisor: Kristina Post, Ph.D.

Examined the relationship between religiosity/nonreligiosity and depression symptoms, including curvilinear patterns of belief strength and the moderating roles of dogmatism and cultural values such as collectivism. Findings highlighted a reverse U-shaped relationship between belief strength and depression, with implications for understanding mental health across diverse belief systems.
