



DOMAINE DES CLOSIERS

Saumur Champigny

The domain

The “Domaine des Closiers” is located in Parnay, in the heart of the Saumur Champigny appellation.

The “closiers” were the vine growers who worked in the vineyards and who lived in the troglodyte dwellings at the foot of the hill.

The estate covers 15 hectares on clay-limestone soil. The vines are 35 years old on average. Set on the hillside of a limestone cliff overlooking the Loire, the plots of the estate express all the richness and nobility of the soil of Saumur Champigny.

The domain has been developing the biodiversity for a long time. In 2019, it began its conversion to organic wine (ecocert). Special attention is paid to tillage and vines.

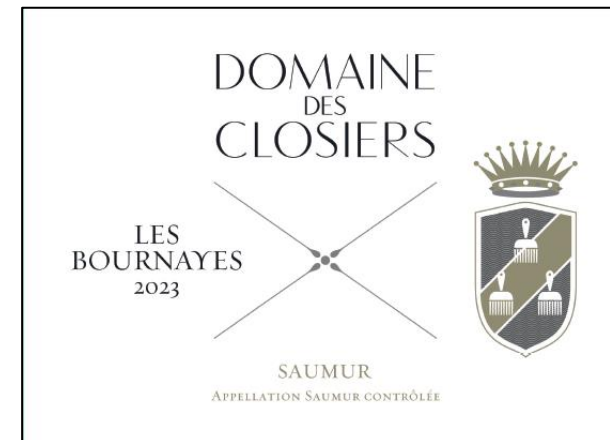
Bournayes 2023

Cuvée Bournayes

The Bournayes cuvée comes from our plots of Chenin located in the place called “Les Bournayes” in Souzay-Champigny.

The grapes are harvested by hand and then pressed before being kept in barrels for fermentation and then aging for 12 months. 3 types of wood are used in order to have the finest and most complex aromatic expression, all in tension and balance (no new barrels).

No product is added during the whole process apart from small quantities of sulfur dioxide to guarantee the stability of our wines, notably during transport.
