

Food Vendor FAQs

Do I need prior festival experience to apply?

Vendors must have 3-4 years of festival or large event experience.

Is insurance mandatory?

Yes, all food vendors are required to carry Commercial General Liability Insurance.

How long do I need to be available to participate as a vendor?

Food Vendors must commit to being available for the entirety of the festival, including the lead-up. Lead vendors need to be on site from July 18th to July 28th, 2026.

When can vendors arrive on site?

The arrival times for Lead Food Vendors is between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm PST, on Saturday, the 18th of July. More information regarding check-in hours and arrival at the site will be communicated closer to the event by the Vendor Manager.

What staffing requirements are there? Are accommodations provided?

Vendors are required to provide their own staff. Each vendor receives 20 tickets, with discounted tickets available for additional staff. Accommodations are not provided, but a vendor camping area is available (placement together not guaranteed). Off-site stays are discouraged once the festival begins.

Is there a water hookup available? Are generators allowed?

A water hookup for all food vendors is provided on-site. No personal generators are allowed on-site unless otherwise pre-approved.

What kind of environment & weather should I be prepared for?

Vendors should be prepared for a high-energy environment with noise, large crowds, and overstimulation. Weather may include extreme heat, cold, rain, dust, and wind.

Are there sustainability requirements?

Yes, all food must be served using compostable utensils, containers, and packaging.
