

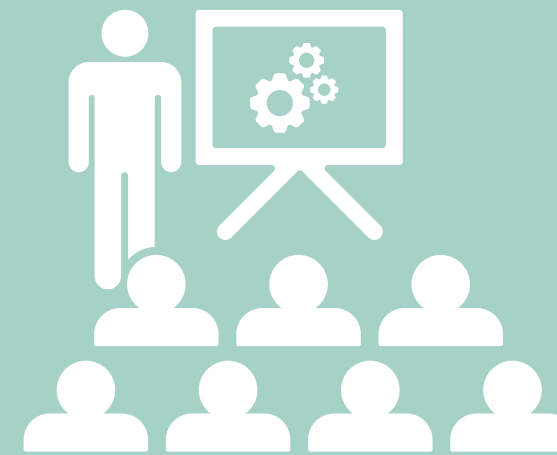

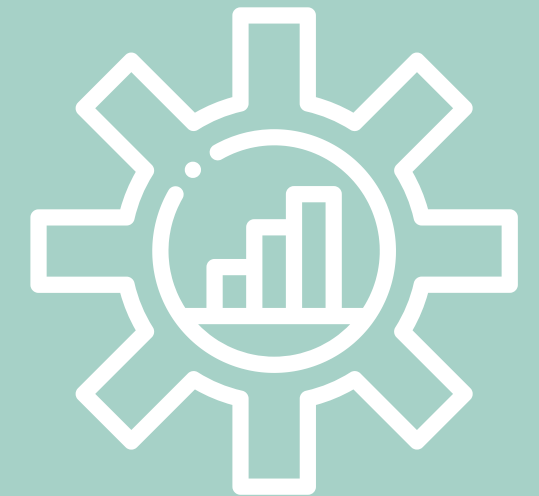

2025: Key Projects & Highlights

Public Sector:

- Lewes District Council: 12-week embedded energy engineer placement reviewing the energy efficiency of leisure centres, swimming pools and grade II listed building
- 33% energy & carbon savings identified; extended contract awarded
- City of London Corporation: Pre-deconstruction audit templates now required by planning dept for all major developments
- Templates to be published on City of London website following pilot projects

Private Sector:

- Flannery Plant Hire (Europe's largest plant hire): ESOS compliance delivered; first operated plant hire company to achieve PAS 2080 certification
- 8 private sector clients supported to achieve ESOS compliance
- Created EPDs for 4 of EPAS's products
- BREEAM pre-deconstruction and fit out support
- District heating and cooling infrastructure support for optimal energy efficiency and operating costs
- Aureos: Independent verification of Scope 1, 2 & 3 GHG emissions (58,322 tCO₂e) + Data Quality Improvement Plan
