30 HOURS FREE VS TAX-FREE CHILDCARE

Tax-Free Childcare is different: For every £8 you add, the government adds £2. Up to £2,000 a year per child.



EXAMPLE BASED ON SPREADING HOURS

George attends 3 days a week [31.5 hours] and is eligible for 30 funded hours.

Funded hours spread across the year: $30 \text{ hrs } \times 38 \text{ weeks} \div 51 = 22.35 \text{ hrs/week}.$

Weekly cost:

- Consumables: £23.47
- Non funded hours: £71.46
- Total: £223.47 + £71.46 = £94.83

Monthly Invoice (52 weeks):

£94.83 x 51 ÷ 12 = £403.45 per month

With Tax-Fee Childcare:

It's entirely free and helps cut the cost of your childcare fees.

KEY DATES & DEADLINES

- Apply between 1st September and 31st
 December to receive funding from 1st
 January 2026.
- If your child is in nursery, book free hours in advance to secure additional days.
