
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Wednesday, April 16th to Friday, April 18th, 2025, among a sample of 1124 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Canada. The survey was conducted using IVR. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Canada.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2.9% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.





If the federal election were held today, how would you vote? (decided and leaning voters)





Do you have a favourable or unfavourable view of Mark Carney? (all voters)






