
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Saturday, January 31st to Monday, February 2nd, 2026, among a sample of 1276 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Canada. The survey was conducted using IVR. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Canada.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2.7% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.




















