
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Friday, February 20th to Sunday, February 22nd, 2026, among a sample of 802 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Toronto. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Toronto. The poll was conducted in English.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3.5% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding.








