
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Friday, February 20th to Sunday, February 22nd, 2026, among a sample of 464 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Scarborough Southwest (Provincial Boundaries). The survey was conducted using live agent surveyors. Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Scarborough Southwest (Provincial Boundaries).

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 4.5% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding.

If a Federal Election were held today in the riding of Scarborough Southwest (Provincial Boundaries), which candidate/party will you vote for? (All Voters)
























