Survey Methodology

Sample & Fieldwork

This survey was conducted by Mainstreet Research using live agent surveyors among n=440 adults 18 years of age or older living in Beaches-East York. Fieldwork was completed March 11–13, 2026. Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Beaches-East York.

Margin of Error

A probability sample of this size would carry a margin of error of ± 4.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 (95% confidence level). Results for sub-groups carry larger margins of error. Totals may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

Weighting

Results have been weighted by gender and age using population targets. Weights are normalized so that the weighted total equals the unweighted total (n=440) in every table.

Vote Intention Reporting

The general election vote intention question is reported three ways: (1) All Voters — raw distribution including all undecideds; (2) Decided + Leaners — respondents who selected Undecided were asked a leaning follow-up; those with a lean are folded into the corresponding party; (3) Decided Voters — hard undecideds excluded from the base entirely. By-election scenario questions (Avi Lewis / Rob Ashton as NDP leader) are reported two ways: All Voters and Decided Voters.

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Key Insights

Highlights of findings outside the margin of error · Sub-groups with n < 50 excluded

Liberals lead strongly in the general election:

Carney (Liberal) leads with 52% among all voters and 67% among decided voters — a commanding advantage in the riding under the current candidate lineup.

Avi Lewis transforms the competitive landscape:

With Avi Lewis as NDP leader and candidate, the by-election becomes highly competitive. Among decided voters, Lewis leads Carney 43% to 39% — a dramatic shift from the general election baseline.

CPC support stable across all scenarios:

Poillievre/CPC holds between 13–17% across all scenarios and voter bases, indicating a consistent ceiling for Conservative support in this riding.

Rob Ashton produces a more modest NDP surge:

Under Rob Ashton, the Liberals retain a meaningful lead among decided voters (56% vs 25%), suggesting Ashton generates significantly less NDP momentum than Avi Lewis.

Undecided share is substantial at 20%:

One-in-five voters remain undecided, concentrated among male voters (25.8%) and those in the 18–49 age group (23.6%). This pool is large enough to alter outcomes in a competitive by-election scenario.

Age and gender are key fault lines:

Carney (Liberal) leads most strongly among women (54%) and voters 65+ (59%). CPC support is higher among voters 50+ and men. The NDP (Davies) draws most support from women and younger voters.

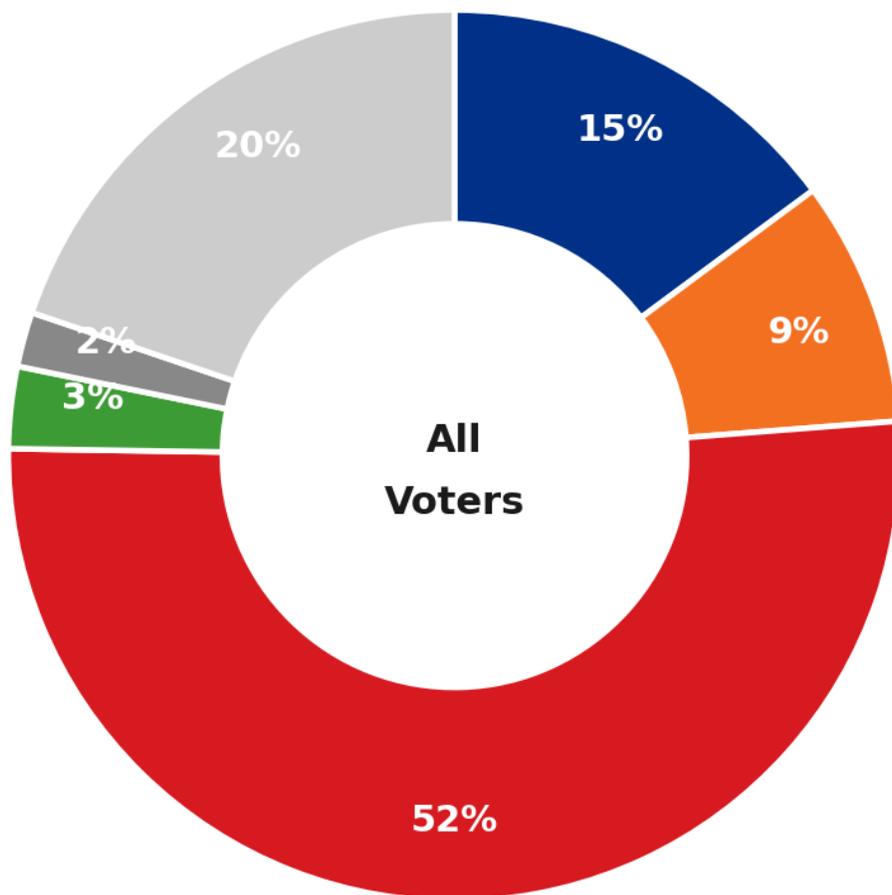

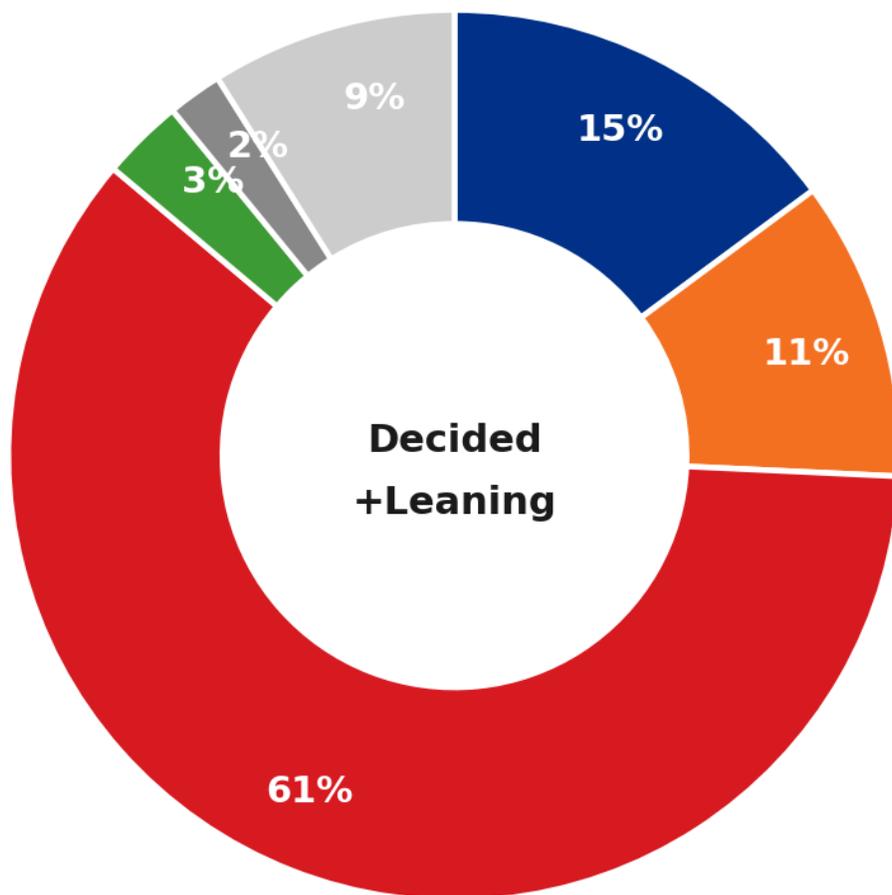

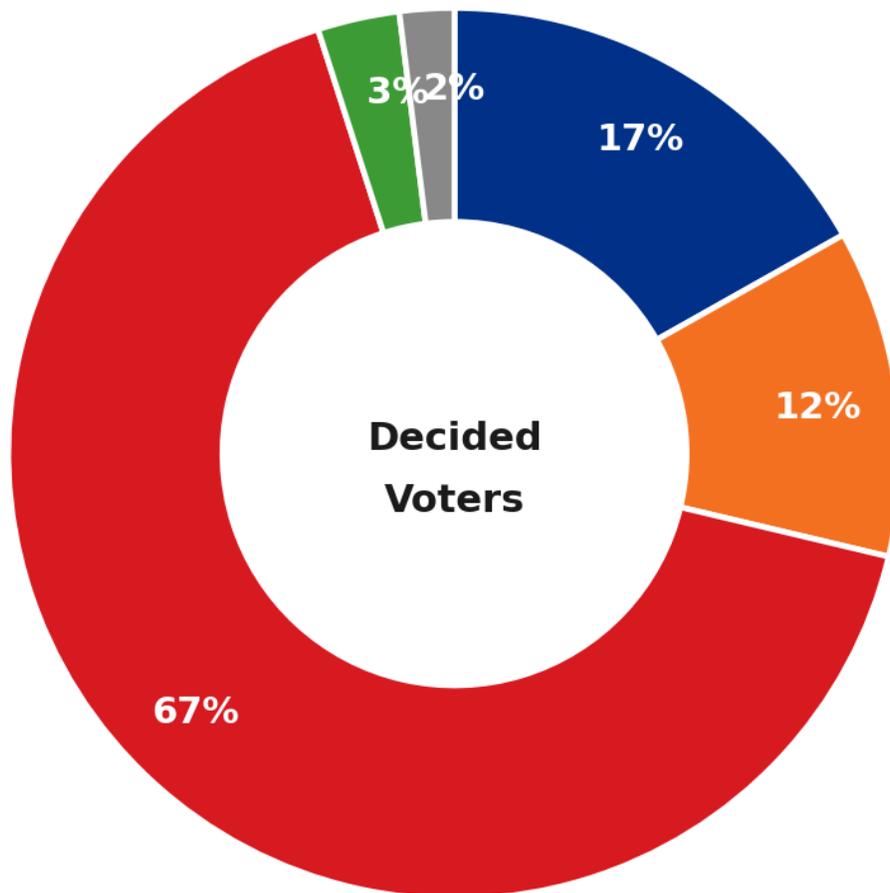

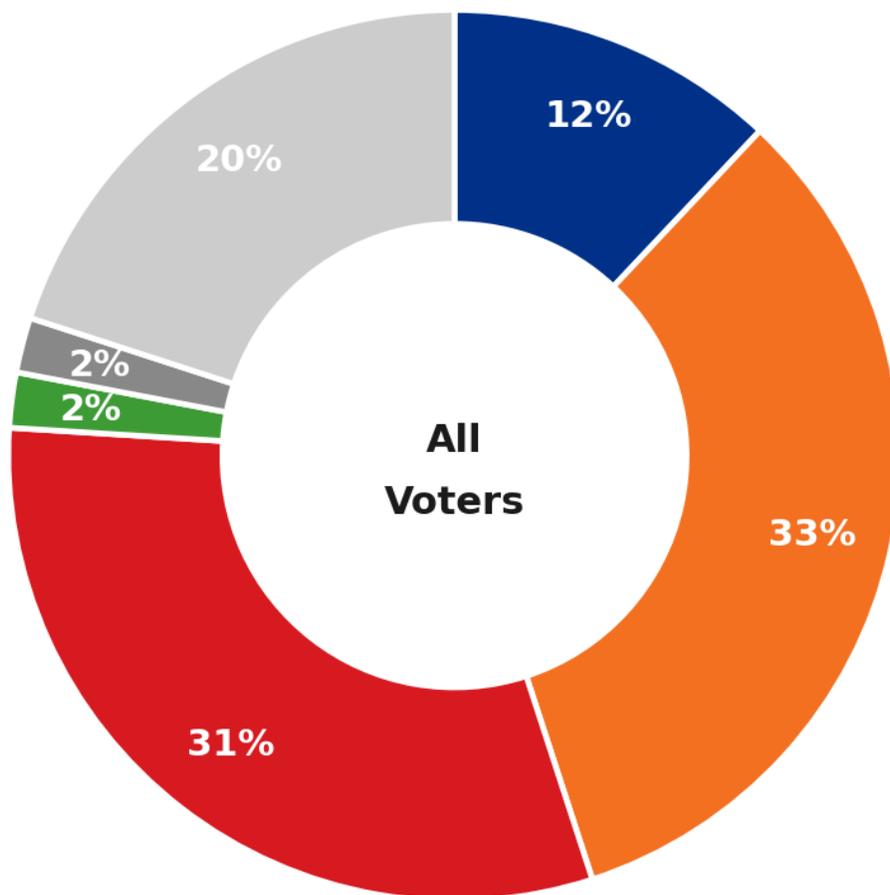

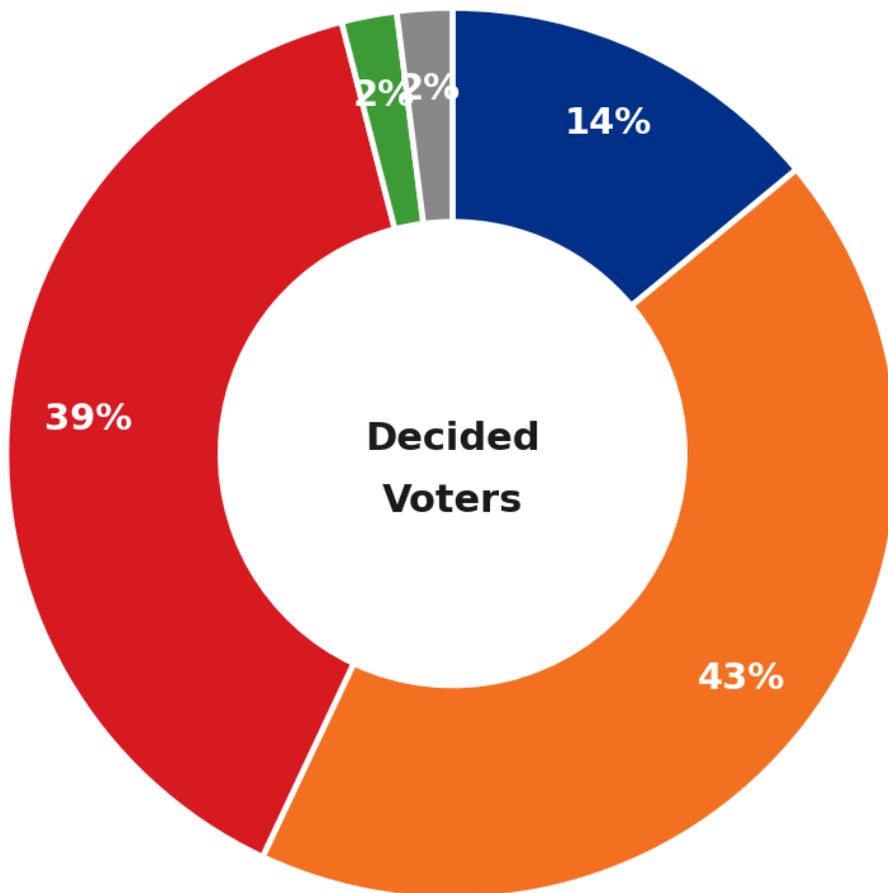

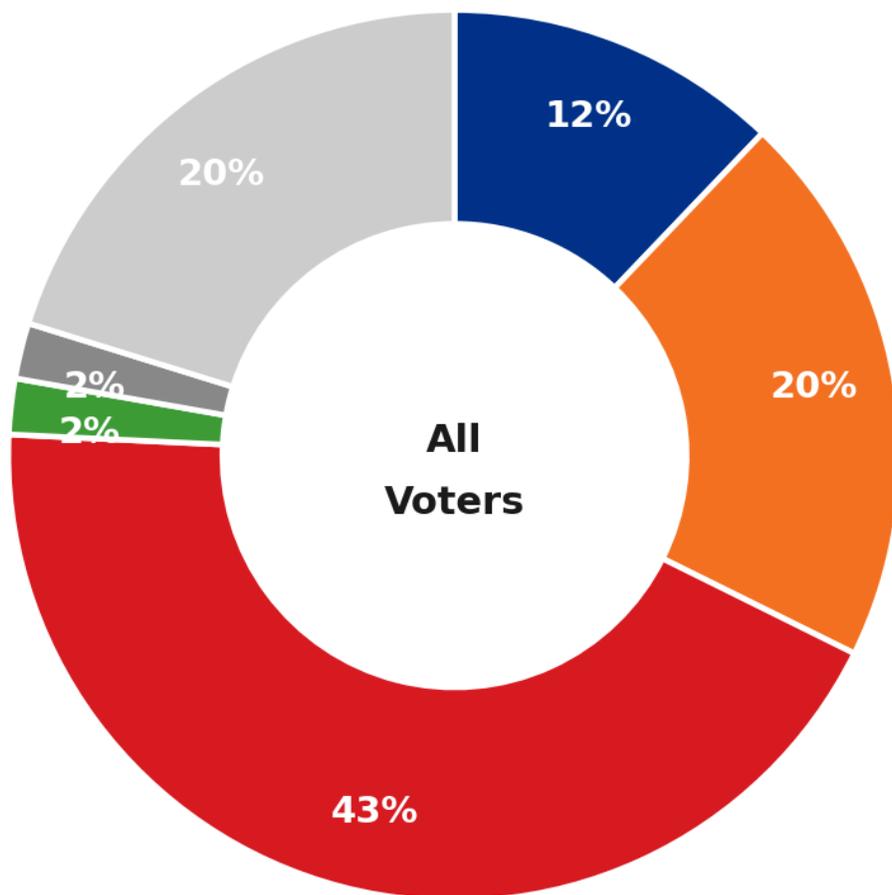

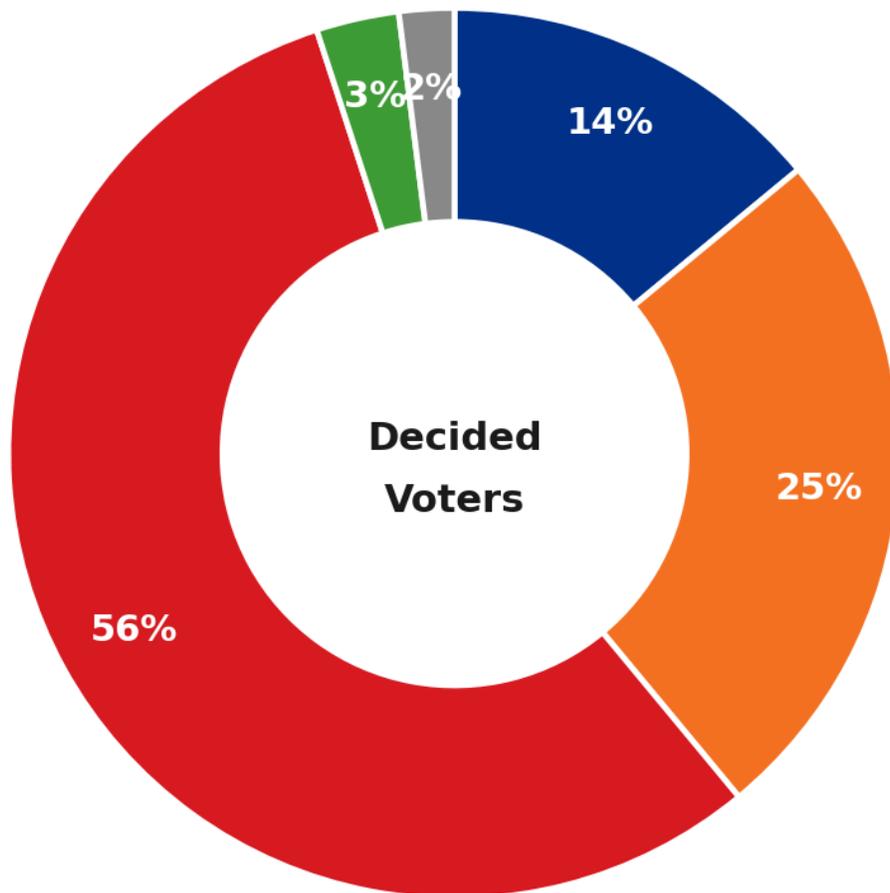
